 5:16 P.M. Trail to N Rock Quarry (top). Orange-Crowned warbler nest previously described still in tact.
 5:21 P.M. Top of N Rock Quarry.
 5:24 P.M. Left.
 5:25 P.M. Bee House or 1 hr & 23 min. in field. At entrance to Bee Estate a *Vanessa* butterfly.
 6:35 P.M. 65 glaucous-winged gull on Flower Island.
 7:35 P.M. adult ♀ river otter and 3 young $\frac{2}{3}$ size of ♀ swim N and fished. ♀ mainly light with one conspicuous dark spot (5 x 2 inches)

 a mule deer Aug 1, 1987

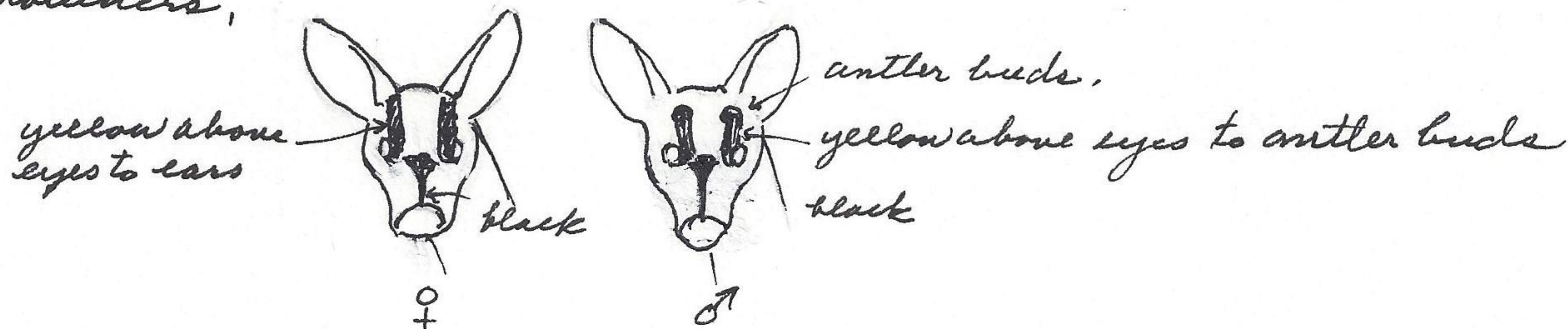
8:10 A.M. Bimbam, (30" high at shoulders) fed 8 min. on corn and wheat, then hand fed $\frac{1}{2}$ apple. A domestic rabbit fed 12" from front hoof of this deer. The deer lowered head and nudged the rabbit away. No contact. ^{antlers $\frac{3}{4}$ " longer than last observed and more upright} Bimbam has scar between shoulder and on rump

8:25 A.M. Shy Deer, a mule deer at feeder, 29" at shoulder. She has $\frac{1}{4}$ " scar just above wrist of front right leg (medially). Shy above clear, clouds in low horizon.

11:00 A.M. Sister, a mule deer, at feeder. 27" high at shoulders. Scar upper part shoulder blade, right  → ANTERIOR
 Left middle trail under stairs.

11:10 A.M. Skull Cap ♀, a mule deer at feeder, 25" high at shoulders, very spooky.

11:40 A.M. Skull Cap ♂, a mule deer at feeder, 25" high at shoulders,



The neck and anterior part of body has light long post-juvenile (^{not}spotted) pelage.

1:16 P.M. 9 barn swallows concentrated at Boundary Point

Barn swallows are rarely observed from Bee House, and also northern-green swallows kept when nesting at the house. Barn swallows from water level to 60' high
