

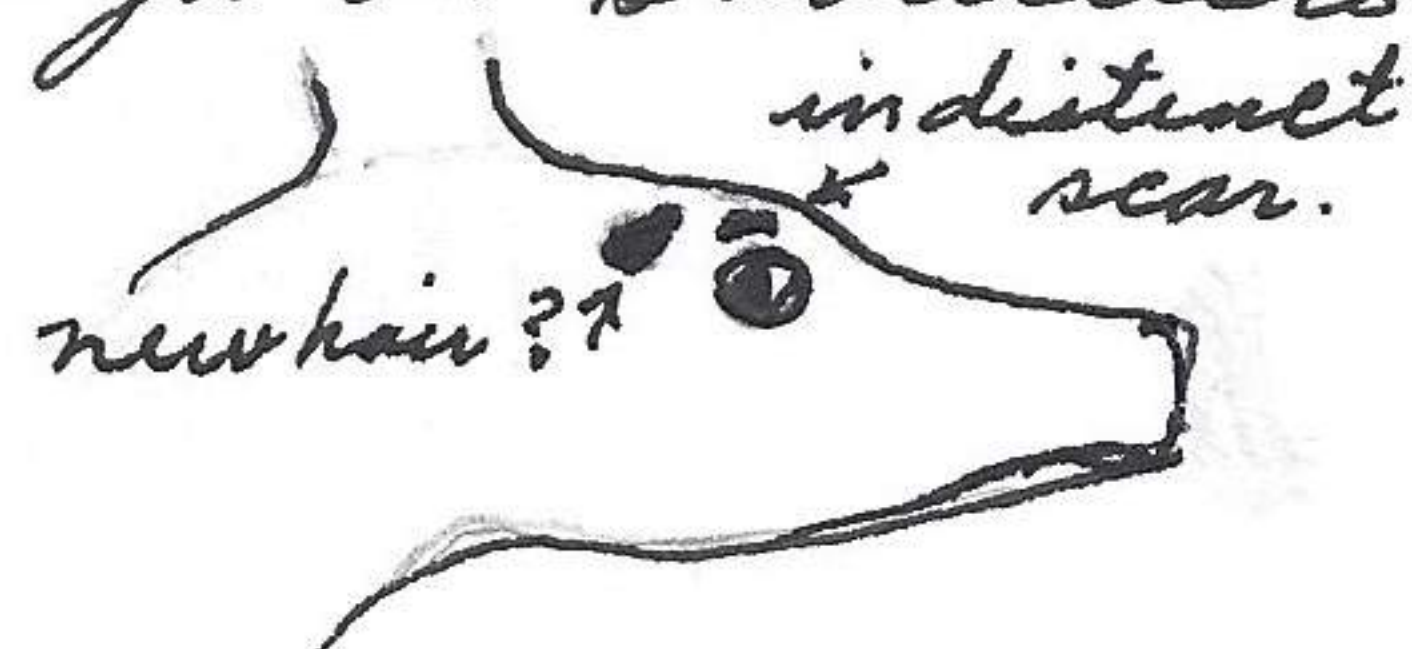
Aug 7, 1987
 6:30 A.M. 91 glaucous-winged gulls Flower Island, 2 d.p. cormorant. Nest 2' high tide
 7:11 A.M. Ad bald eagle passed Bee House from N at 50' high
 and 20' from shore, dropped to 15', circled Spring Cove above water
 and continued S alighting in Douglas fir above point (see locat-
 ion on ^{pictorial} map date May 5, 1987). Remain for 45 minutes.

8:30 A.M. Chevron Doe, a mule deer and her fawn fed 6
 minutes at feeder.

8:35 A.M. Lister, a mule deer, at feeder for 6 minutes. She
 was hand fed apple slices

10:57 A.M. ad. female river otter and 3 young fed along shoreline
 (in shallow water) below Bee House. They continued to S side Spring
 Cove and left water (approx - 2.4) moved over beach along cone
 to logs at high tide level and then W on slope of spring among
 trees. They returned to water at 11:11 A.M. or 14 minutes on land
 They continued S, feeding in water at shoreline. This family
 group is the same as group observed Aug 1, 1987. Female had
 same spotty pattern.

12:15 new female mule deer, ^{Scar Lid} at feeder, 30" high at shoulders
 and scar mark above eye and behind eye
 on right side. Fawn 20 1/2" high at shoulders



Aug 8, 1987
 7:10 A.M. adult ♀ and 3 young river otter swarm ^{5' from shore} N by Bee
 House, feeding along way.

7:20 A.M. adult bald eagle flew S by Bee House 150' SE from
 shoreline and approx 80' high.

7:50 A.M. Shy Doe displaced fawn of Chevron with forceful
 thrust of right front foot. I do not see how these repelling
 acts do not injure eyes of the displaced one. More scars this year
 than last year.

10:18 A.M. Check of boat traffic this Saturday morning:

32 boats all told

sail boats 10 of which 7 going N (4 with sails, 3 without sails)
 and 3 going S (1 with sails, 2 without)

motor boats. 22 in all, 1 going S, 21 going N.

Wind from N, small whitecaps.

10:20 A.M. 49 glaucous-winged gulls on Flower Island.

9 harbor seal on Leo Reef. Rocks 1-6. no other seal

10:50 A.M. 32 sail & motor boats (6 going S, 26 going N)

10:55 A.M. This A.M. on 3 occasions a belted kingfisher sat
 on edge of rocky slope (6' above water) for 2-3 minutes each time.

12:30 A.M. 28 boats in sound SE Bee House from Thatcher Pass to
