

10:30 A.M. 28 Harbor seal on Leo Reef (Rocha 3-5), 3 on Little Flower Rock.

3 band-tailed pigeons flew from Bee House, across north Lopez Sound to Bladely Island

at around noon, approx 600 gulls rested in 3 different groups on outer edge of low tide in Swift Bay.  I did not have binoculars at that time but recognized gull, mew gull and California gull in area. 21 glaucous-winged gulls in area. The group of gulls were predominately either mew or California gulls. At high tide in late afternoon there were no gulls in Swift Bay except 4 glaucous-winged gulls.

8:40 P.M. Sister, a mule deer, at feeder (Bee House)

To Friday Harbor by ferry. 2 Bonaparte gulls between Lopez and Shaw, 1 marbled murrelet, 1 glaucous-winged gull at Orcas ferry landing and one American Crow, 2 barn swallows.

at low tide, bottom sediments are dispersed 60'-80' from ferry at Orcas dock.

S of Shaw Island 49 Bonaparte gulls on tidal current contact.

9 Indian  fishing boat on SE end Shaw,  5 side.

1/2 mile W, 12 glaucous-winged gulls on tidal current fringe.

Return to Lopez from Friday Harbor. 71 of Turn Island to E end Shaw, 3 groups of glaucous-winged gulls ^{immatures} (8) (4) (18) (105) (36) (45). 7 rhinoceros auklets, 2 rhinoceros, 3 Bonaparte gulls, all on rip tides (edges).

E side Shaw Island to Orcas, 2 glaucous-winged gulls

From Orcas landing 3/10 mi. E, 2 Turkey vultures.

7 glaucous-winged gulls at Shaw ferry terminal, 4 on piling.

From Shaw ferry landing to Lopez ferry landing 5 glaucous-winged gulls.

Aug 12, 1987

Adult ♀ mule deer, 30" high at shoulders, with 2 fawns 21 1/2" high at shoulders. ad. no scars, ears occasionally flopped. Both fawn with spots.
