

Aug 13, 1987

To Mt. Vernon, Wash. Left 9:35 A.M. Leo Reef had 9 harbor seal on N side, none on S side.

Middle Rosario Straits 3 Bonaparte gulls, 2 glaucous-winged gulls. Small white caps.

Anacortes ferry terminal, 3 Bonaparte gulls.

Continued to Chris' home at Lost Lake.

To Northwest Oncology Clinic, Cabrini Medical Tower, Seattle. To check with Dr. Glenn A Warner. Thence back to Chris'

Aug 15, 1987

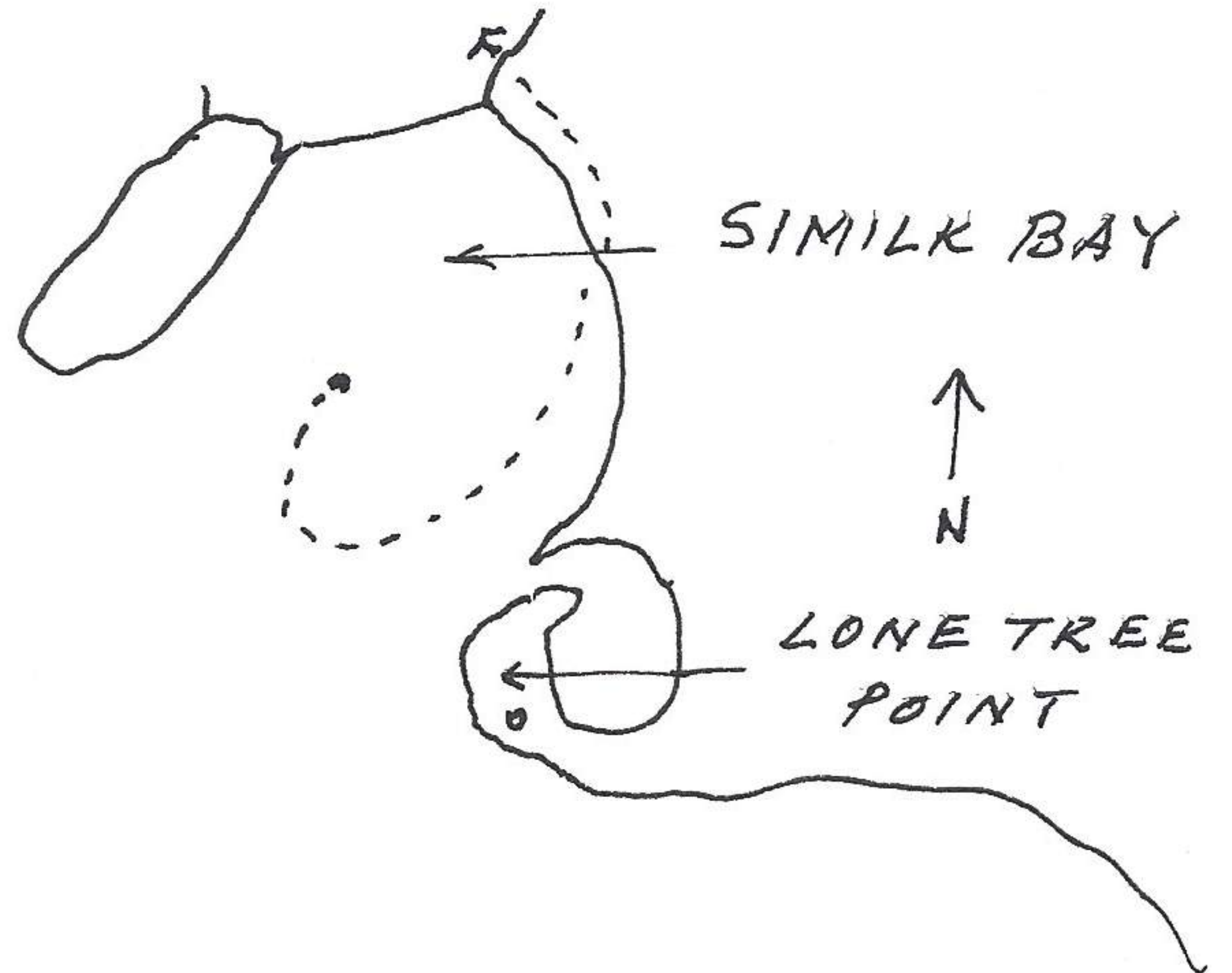
Chris' to Thousand Trail Preserve.

Aug 16, 1987

All day Thousand Trails.

9:00 A.M. to Lone Tree Point. 3 ring-billed gulls, 1 glaucous-winged gull, 1 Bonaparte gull. A Caspian tern was being harassed at water level by a glaucous-winged gull & a Bonaparte gull. The tern left area, flew S, then NE to height of conifers^{'00'} on ridge & then N beyond sight.

Also 2 black turnstones left Lone Tree Point and flew W to barge associated with Indian fishing area. They alighted on a log nest to barge. 2 double-crested cormorants, 1 great blue heron, 3 American crows, 14 surf scoters, 8 barn swallows and 1 Bonaparte gull



Employee at T.T. said an adult bald eagle and 2 young perched on Lone Tree Point (Douglas fir) on several occasions during the week, sometimes as long as 2 hrs. Several other eagles have been sighted within T.T. Preserve, some flying 10'-15' above roads.

At Lone Tree Point noted a beaver cut red alder.

5 immature glaucous-winged gulls rested on shoreline for at least 1/2 hr.

Current passing S of Lone Tree Point at 6 sec. per 10'
