18 Bonaparte gulls approx. 200 ft SE Bee House. no other birds in sound between Leo Reef & Bee House.

To Friday Harbor by ferry. 35 Bonaparte gulls between Shaw and Orcas ferry terminals. 8 Bonaparte gulls in Upright Channel. 130 Bonaparte gulls in San Juan Channel to Friday Harbor, also 1 rhinoceros auklet and 8 marbled murrelets. James Robert and I checked the 32' Jensen trawler 'Isleña' that belongs to Mr. James & Ruth Byers, 5110 Beach Lane, Cattle Point area, San Juan Co. 378-2609. Returned to Lopez.

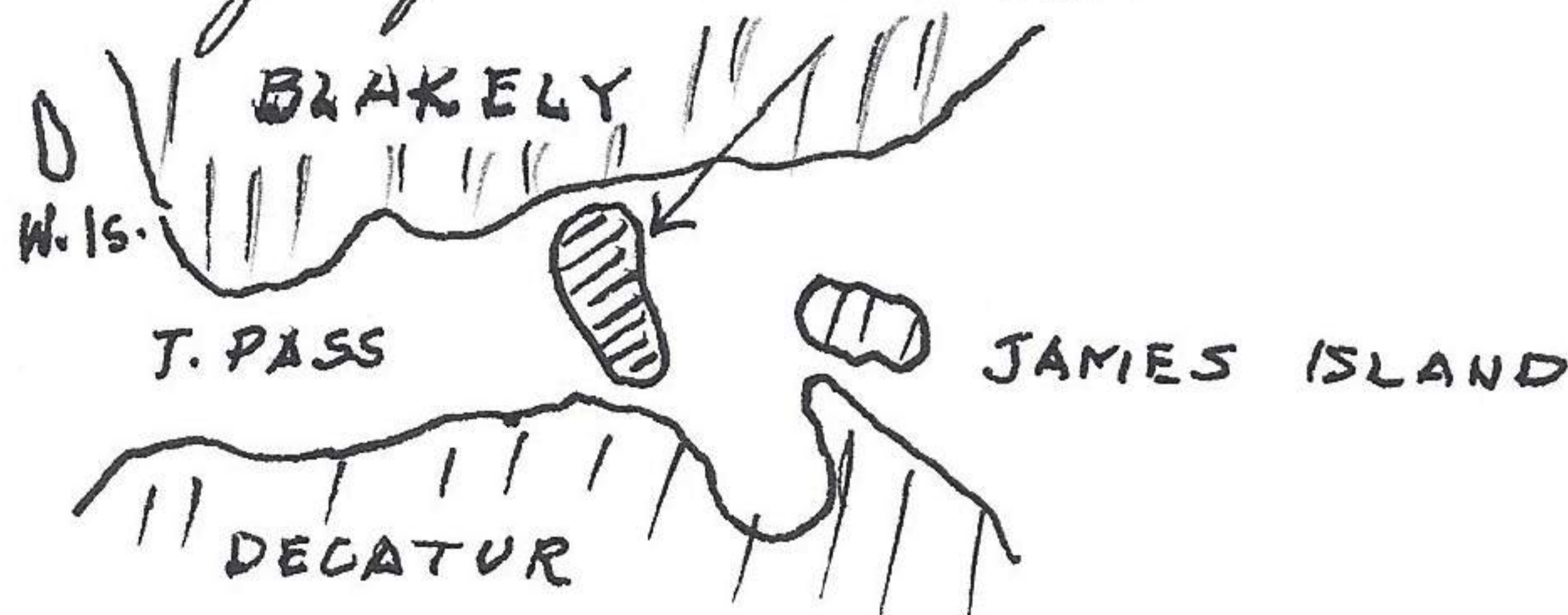
Aug 19, 1987

a bat (^{or 5"} 4" wing spread) active yesterday evening at a hour that appeared to be early for bat activity. This morning the bat was active to 6:10 A.M. Sky clear but fog bank approaching from E.

Group 13 Bonaparte gulls in front Bee House 100'-300' from shore. They occurred yesterday also.

Belted Kingfisher perched in madrona below Bee House, 20' above shoreline.

10:25 A.M. To Anacortes. Bonaparte gulls in following numbers between Lopez ferry terminal and Wend Thatcher Pass, 1-1-1-2-1-1. From Wend Thatcher Pass to observed concentration of approx 800 Bonaparte gulls, generally distributed along rip tides thus: also 2 marbled murrelets, 4 glaucous winged gulls. Between here (above) and Anacortes ferry terminal 4 Bonaparte gulls.



Returned to Lopez 5:15 P.M. 2 Bonaparte gulls w end Thatcher Pass, 1 at Willow Island and a marbled murrelet between Willow Island and Lopez ferry terminal. Quite a contrast to same route this A.M.

This evening, Buster and Chevron at feeder, 1/2 hr. later Chevron and fawn

7:45 P.M. 91 glaucous-winged gulls on Flower Island, 4 young about size of adults but not yet airborne. One adult fed young in nest. Also 8 double-crested cormorant. 15 Bonaparte flew past to SW.
