To Friday Harbor. Left 9:10 A.M. Day Clear. Census as follows:
 Lopez to Shaw (ferry terminals), 1 Bonaparte gull, 2 Bonaparte gulls,
 1 glaucous-winged gull. At Shaw ferry terminal 16 glaucous-winged
 gulls, all adult except one, also 1 kingfisher (belted). At Oress
 ferry terminal 1 adult glaucous-winged gull, 3 American crows,
 2 barn swallows. In Upright Channel, 1 Bonaparte gull, 1 gl.-
 winged gull, 2 Bonaparte gulls. San Juan Channel 5 Shaw Island
 2 Bonaparte gull. Arrived Friday Harbor 10:20 A.M.

At Mrs Henry Byers 839 Terrace Dr. observed 2 adult and
 6, 1 foot high (from back) wild turkey as a family group. They were
 dusting in dry dirt, then fed thru garden and finally left area.
 Mr Byers said he has observed 30 turkeys at one time in garden
 area. The wild turkeys were introduced 2 years ago at Roche
 Harbor. Ring-necked pheasant common 10-15 years ago, now rare.
 Few, at least one family of Calif. quail on his property. meadowlarks
 in early days now rare.

From Byers crossed wooded area of U.W. to marine station.
 no administrator on duty, thence to Friday Harbor ferry terminal
 via shoreline from residential area to N. In the trail of wooded area
 N. UW marine station, in area of ^{red} alder, leaves completely covered trail,
 no birds in forest.

At 150' N Custom building, Friday Harbor, among boulders on beach,
 noted a *Thamnophis* (blue stripes) 7/8 inches wide (body).
