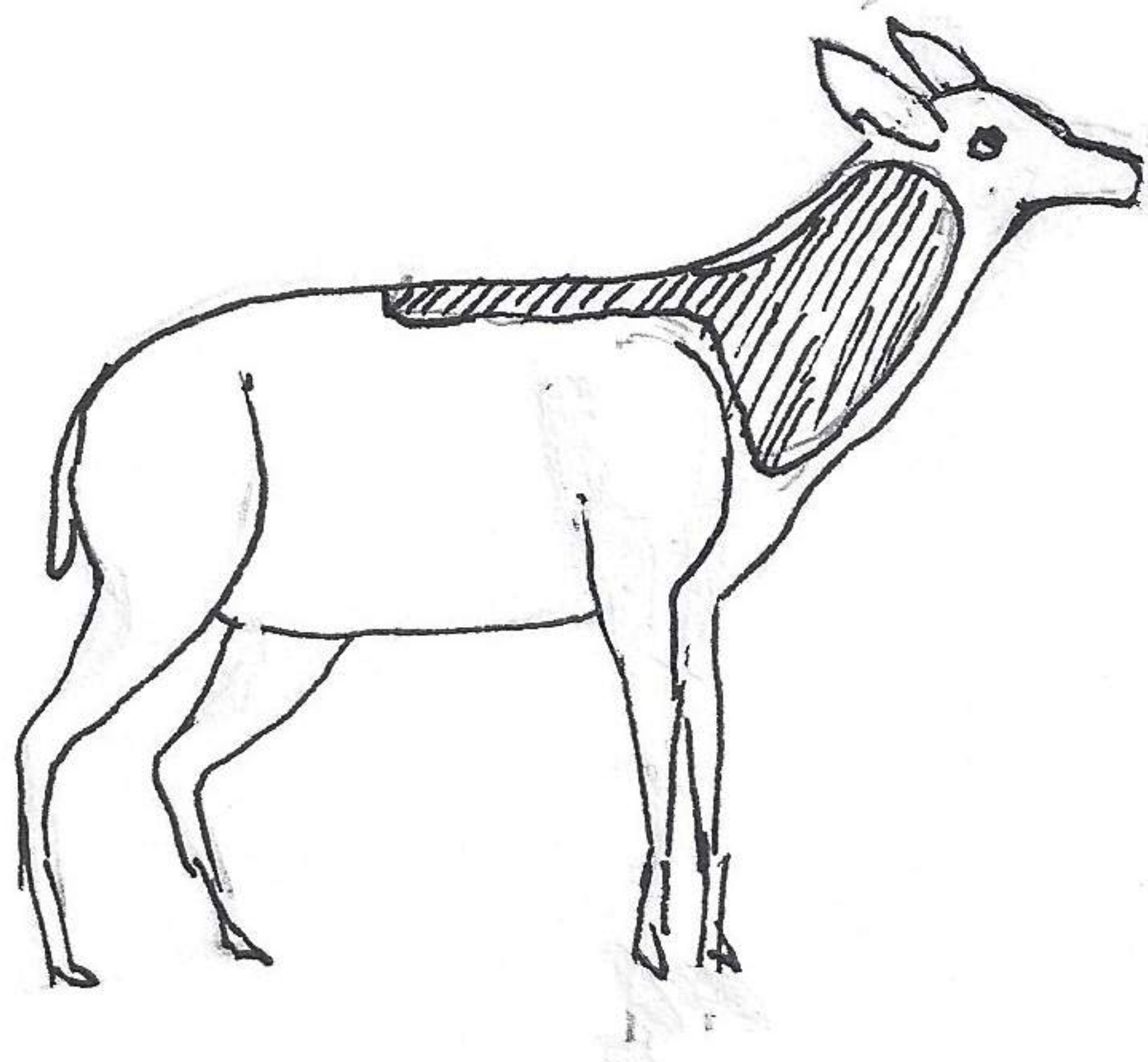


Sept 10, 1987

8:56 A.M. 3 river otter to N in front of Bee House 10' from shore.

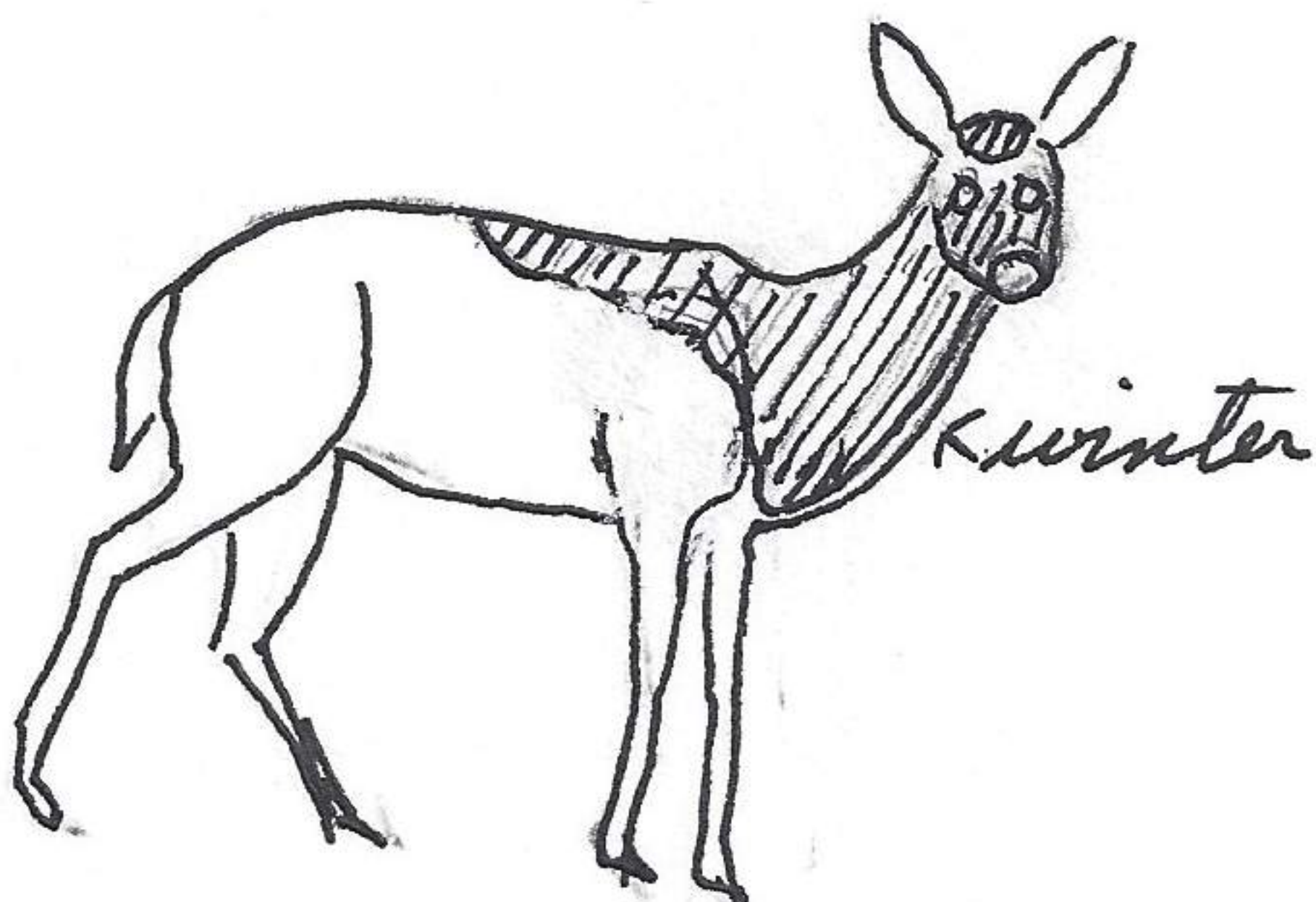
Trip to Rosarus Resort for brunch. From top mt. Constitution 1 Turkey vulture 200' below top to E.
