Photo 870921-5 of a shark approx. 4' long.

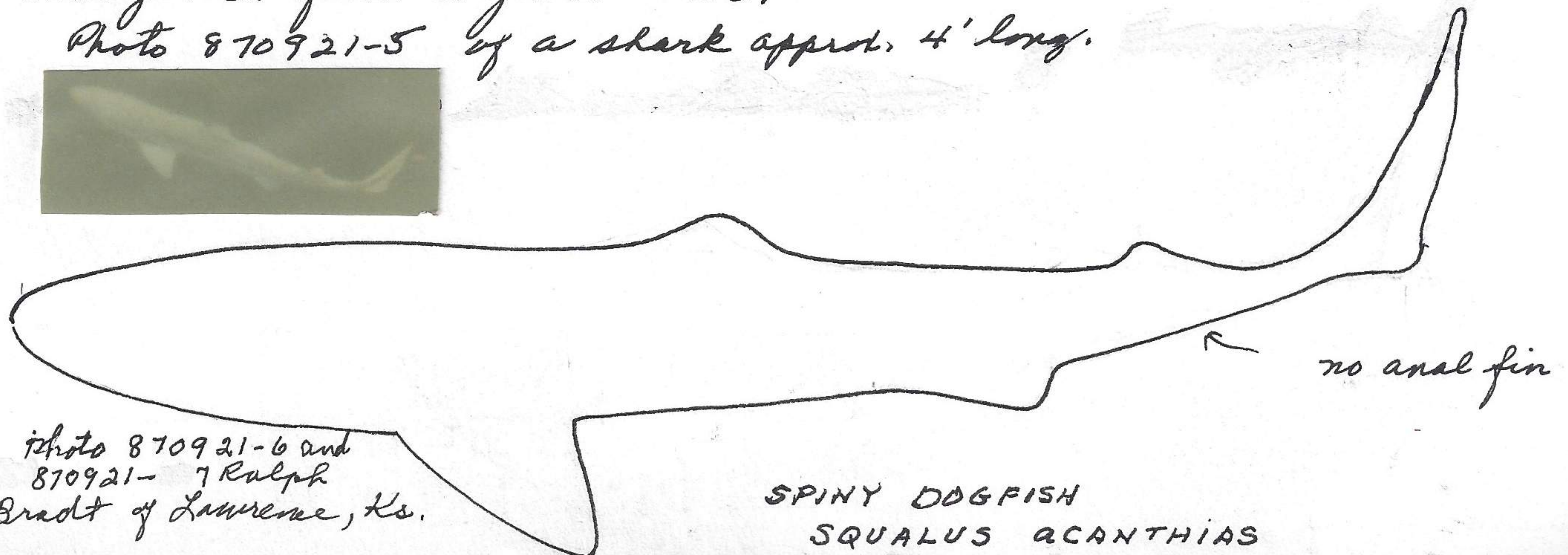
