

channel: 31 red-breasted mergansers, 21 single Bonaparte gulls, 14
glaucous-winged gulls, 2 surf scoters, no currents but ripples in
San Juan Channel. From Flat Point observed (to 3/4 way across
San Juan Channel observed 4 separate groups of feeding birds
including 200 glaucous-winged gulls, 30 Herrmann gulls, approx
300 Bonaparte gulls, 65 mew gulls. Each group was associated with
12 to 30 cormorants (80% double-crested, 20% pelagic). For the entire
channel covered (S.G.C) approx 3000 glaucous-winged gulls. Wind
from N and good currents. 21 Bonaparte gulls in Friday Harbor.
Arrived 10:48 A.M.

Left Friday Harbor ferry terminal 1:20 P.M. At this time the sub-
merged rock in middle of channel was being prepared for blasting.
In Fri Harbor Bay, Bonaparte gulls in groups or individuals: 8, 4, 1, 1, 1,
16, 1, 1, glaucous-winged gulls, 6, 1, 1. To E end Turn Island (currents),
28 Bonaparte gulls, 12 glaucous-winged gulls. In center San Juan
Channel in currents; Bonaparte gulls 1, 1, 1, 1, 18, 145. and generally dis-
tributed, glaucous-winged gulls, 8, 18, 210 and generally distributed;
1 common loon. Approaching Flat Point and out of main cur-
rent zone: 4 common murrelets, 3 marbled murrelets, 2 harbor seal,
18 cormorants; 81 glaucous-winged gulls, 120 Bonaparte gulls, 4 com-
mon loon. Flat Point to Harney Channel via Upright Head Channel;
4 Bonaparte gulls, 21 glaucous-winged gulls generally distributed.
Harney Channel to Shaw: one group approx 100 gulls (50-50 glaucous-
wing and Bonaparte gulls), 2 double crested cormorant, 8 mew gulls,
2 ring-billed gulls. At Areas ferry terminal 6 double-crested
cormorant, 2 glaucous-winged gulls, 2 American crows.
Arrived Lopez Island.

Oct. 21, 1987

6:42 A.M. bat still flying and first horned grebe in area. 7 mule deer
at feeder.

Oct 22, 1987

2 ♂ mule deer in area, one 32" high at shoulders, giving a female
full attention. Burnham also in area.

10:20 A.M. 7 river otter E of Bee House, one came to rocks to feed on
a large prey.

12:40 P.M. 6 otter swimming south past Bee House.

1:00 P.M. now otters passing Lichen Point after put-out for several (6)
minutes.

2:10 P.M. 64 double-crested cormorant and 34 harbor seal on Leo Reef.

3:30 P.M. Ram, a mule deer at Bee feeder. 32" high at shoulder,
