 1 red-necked grebe 20' from shore below Bee House. From 8-15 darked-eyed juncos at feeder at Bee House on a daily regular basis. Rufous hummingbird average 1 in 3 days at feeder. Song sparrow at feeder every other day. Townsend chipmunks 2-5 every day. a ♀ mule deer urinated 3' from a male mule deer.
 10:20 A.M. a pileated woodpecker worked Douglas fir from ground to 1 1/2' high.

Oct 28, 1987

a 4 point ♂ mule deer (32" high at shoulders + without eye tines) chased "Buster" a ♀ mule deer from 7:00 A.M. to 9:31 A.M. One ♂ chased 2 ♀ and 2 fawns of the year. Buster chased a fawn, a ♀ chased Buster. a spice male stood 10' from a large 4 point buck.

 8:10 A.M. a harbor seal swam 2 feet under water for approx. 100' and out 16' from shore. a Common loon called twice.
