

Common raven called for 1 hr near Bee House.

Nov. 7, 1987

8 river otter 10-20' out from shore and swim NE past Bee House. Simbam, a mule deer, worked antlers on a dead young juniper tree, although velvet gone for several weeks.

Nov. 5, 1987

Fall color of deciduous trees above fault scar on Blakely gradually disappearing, 2 out of ten trees have lost leaves. From last week bright yellow to golden in color have faded to a faded golden.

At 6:10 P.M. 2 adult male mule deer, one of which had the following antler configuration, also 2 1 year olds and 4 young of this year were with the males at the feeder.



Nov. 6, 1987

5 mule deer at feeder, one with a black cap (25 1/2" high shoulders) which is a twin of one of larger ♀'s.

Nov 7, 1987

1:10 P.M. 6 river otter NE feeding leisurely as they past Bee House. A fawn of the year checked odor of posterior of adult ♀ mule deer and attempted 2 times to mount its mother at Bee House feeder.

Nov. 8, 1992

Pre-sunrise red sky. First glaucous-winged gull active 6:42 A.M.

Tail band wider in mew gull than in Bonaparte.

7:46 A.M. Harbor seal 50' from shore below Bee House.

8:15 A.M. 4 Bonaparte and 9 mew gulls fed on 1 1/2" minnows in front Bee House.
30 crab pots placed in Swift Bay 5 days ago.

Black-faced fawn 25" high at shoulders at Bee House feeder.

2:25 P.M. 1 river otter swim N past Bee House. It made several 80' underwater passages
