

1:30 A.M. 15 ♀ and 1 ♂ Common mergansers, 23 double-crested cormorant, 3 pelagic cormormants, 12 glaucous-winged gulls and 7 Bonaparte gulls in on feeding formation. The merganser after finishing a local feeding area with other above birds, swam to Lichen Point, thence along shoreline to Spring Cove, thence Boundary Point then S back to Lichen Point in 1 hr and 14 minutes.

Nov. 13, 1987

Trip to Richardson at 1:40 P.M. 2 adult bald eagles enroute. at junction Fishermans Bay and Davis Bay roads approx 1300 american crows covering 10 acre field, ^{Lopez} 3 mi N approx, 900 ♂ & ♀ red-winged blackbirds. at 1/2 mi S, High School on Center Road one group, approx. 700 starling. at SE of 1917 School House, approx 500 brown headed cowbirds. associated were 21 Brewers blackbirds and 13 starling.

Nov. 14, 1987

Day clear, low clouds to E, temp. 42°F.

6:20 A.M. bat, myotis size, flew back and forth in front Bee House window (3rd story facing SE) 5 times in 4 minutes at twilight.

6:40 A.M. first glaucous-winged gull flew S past Bee House.

7:50 A.M. ad. bald eagle flew S, 7:15 A.M. ad. bald eagle flew N.

at this time in morning 3-12 surf scoters fly S toward Scraft Bay generally 1/3 way out to Leo Reef.

10:05 A.M. 2 common river on upper part of ridge SW Bee House both call froglike every 3 seconds.

10:10 1 hooded merganser in Spring Cove & feeding.

10:18 Red-tailed hawk circling (SE Bee House 100' high and 40' from shore) and chased by American Crow.

1:20 P.M. 5 river otter swim S past Bee House.

1:45 P.M. 12 .22 rifle shots from O'Leary's home.

Nov. 15, 1987

A.M. 6:59 first bald eagle flew S past Bee House.

7:33 A.M. 2 ad. bald eagles flew N past Bee House (out 40' from shore and 45' high).

Last color of deciduous trees above Fault Line, Beakely Island.
