

Dec. 3, 1987

Rained all last night.

9:00 A.M. Greatest number logs in front Bee House. The logs ranged from 2' to 40' long. 18 logs moving out of Spring Cove.

6 eastern gray squirrels at Bee feeder at one time. The frequent bob-tailed squirrel not present.

Left Lopez Island 10:00 A.M. via ferry for Chris' at Lost Lake in Snohomish Co. Don Jensen will pick up Mary at Seattle airport at noon Monday. Enroute observed a bald eagle circling below mt. Erie over the Lake on S side of mt. Continued down Widbey Island. Birds in sound at Mukeltio: 2 western grebes, 8 common goldeneye, 1 red-necked grebe, 6 Bonaparte gulls, 6 glaucous-winged gulls, 1 double-crested cormorant.

Dec. 8, 1987

Don Jensen reported water, about one foot, over road on E side Swift Bay on Dec. 6th to 8th and also over Humphrey Lagoon Road. On return from Chris I observed 32 glaucous-winged gulls flying past ferry after dark at 9:05 P.M., being in light of ferry search light.

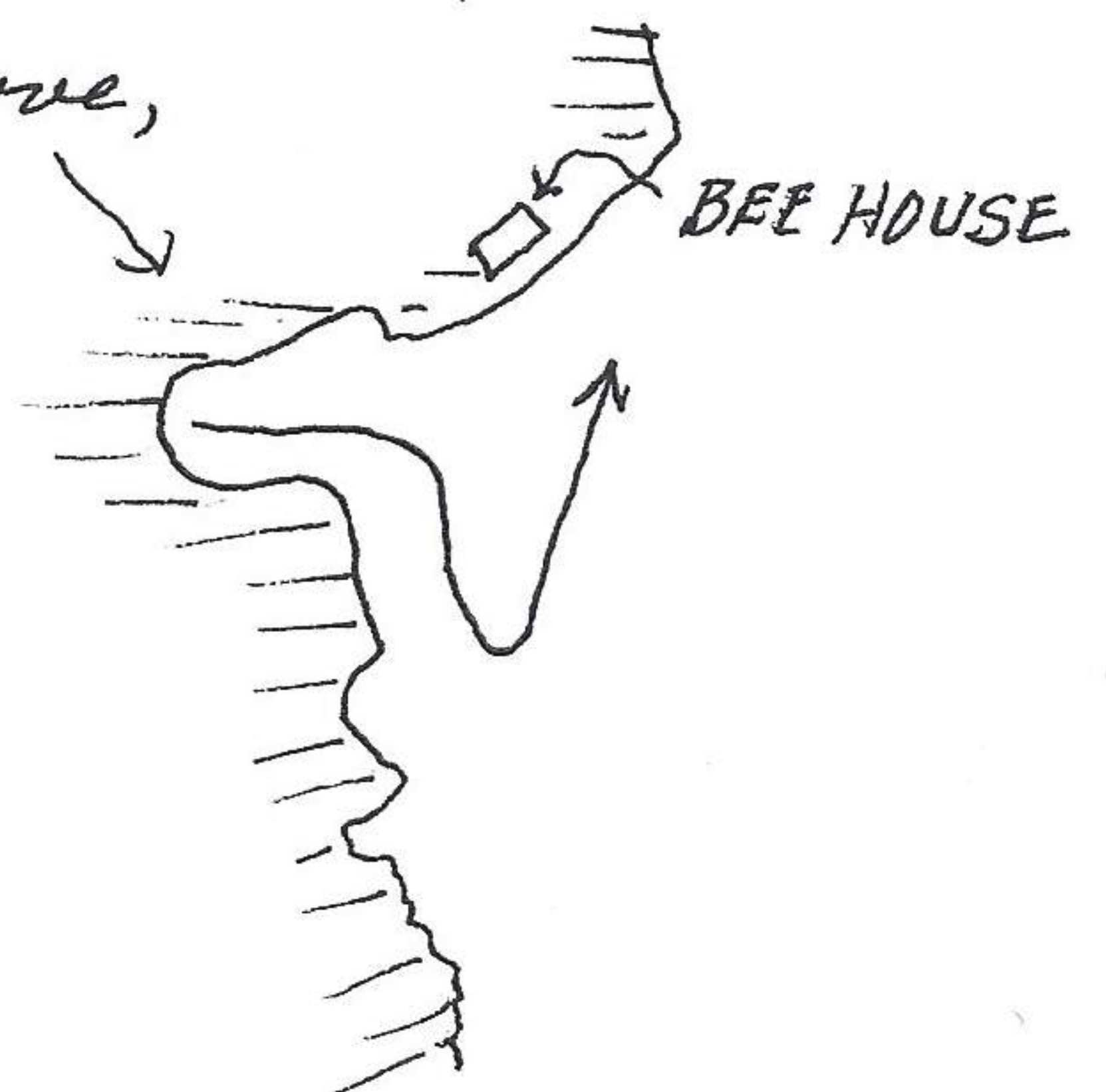
Dec. 9, 1987

8:20 A.M. ad. bald eagle flew N past Bee House. 5 hooded mergansers in front Bee House.

Driftwood logs in Spring Cove after high water. Common mergansers, hooded mergansers, glaucous-winged gulls and double-crested cormorants in Spring Cove in fishing formation for minnows.

Dec. 10, 1987

2:23 P.M. Birds in one fishing group: 64 common mergansers, 18 glaucous-winged gulls, 21 double-crested cormorant. Photo 871210-1 of drift-logs leaving Spring Cove, they left to E, then S, then north. A.M.

Trip to Lopez Village, 10:30 A.M. Swift Lagoon 25 mallards, fields E Center and Hill roads, E of junction Hummel Lake and Port Stanley rds, 125 Common crows.
