 6 glaucous-winged gulls. Left on ferry 4:15 P.M. for Lopez
 Island. Red-throated loon, red-throated loon, pelagic corm-
 orant, 23 American crows flying N to Cypress Island, 3 marbled
 murrelets, 1 glaucous-winged gull, 1 pelagic cormorant, 1 double-
 crested cormorant, mew gull, 3 marbled murrelets, double-crested
 cormorant, now N James Island, 2 glaucous-winged gulls, 1
 double-crested cormorant, 3 common murre, 1 double-crested
 cormorant, glaucous-winged gull, double-crested cormorant, com-
 mon murre. now W end Thatcher Pass, double-crested corm-
 orant, 3 double-crested cormorants, 2 common murre, 3 com-
 mon murre, 3 double-crested cormorants, 1 double-crested corm-
 orant, 2 individual double crested cormorants, 2 mew gulls,
 2 double-crested cormorants, 1 glaucous winged gull, 1 common
 murre, harbor seal on Leo Reef, 2 glaucous-winged gulls, 1 mew
 gull, 3 double-crested cormorants, 1 harbor seal, 3 glaucous-winged

 glaucous-winged gulls. Arrive Lopez Island ^{at 4:53 P.M.} 98% of the birds flying
 in Thatcher Pass were going W. Those in N Lopez Sound were flying
 S. The upwells in Rosario Straits and Thatcher Pass but none in
 N Lopez Sound. There have been census along some course in
 which no birds were observed.

- 9:01 A.M. 7 river otter swam ^S out 20' from Bee House shore.
 3 bald eagle sightings from daybreak to 9:00 A.M.
 10:30 A.M. 3 bald eagles flew N over Bee House some 150' high, ordin-
 arily they fly along shoreline below Bee House,
 1:05 P.M. 9 common mergansers flew N out 300' from shore.
 1:20 P.M. 25 common mergansers flew S ^{at 300'} out 200' from shore
 1:25 P.M. 2 adult bald eagles circled S ^{at 300'} from Humphrey Head to
 over Leo Reef. A glaucous-wing accompanied eagle but was not
 aggressive.
 50 double-crested cormorant on Leo Reef, no harbor seal.
 26 American crows on Bee feeder.
 32 common merganser flew S and alighted out 50' from Lichen Point,
 thence swimming to Spring Cove and then all left Spring Cove in
 unison flight. When fishing several ^{mergansers} at a time would paddle on
 water ^{8'10'} to join current activity.
