Radical parotid, submandibular and neck lymph nodes at Skegitt Valley Hospital, Dr. Gary Johnson.

Jan 5 to Jan 9, 1988

Recovery of above.

Jan 10, 1988

First purple finch at feeder at Bee House on Lopez Island.
2 ♂ and 1 ♀.

2:30 P.M. to river otter swimming S past Bee House.

Jan 11, 1988

7:35 A.M. 1 river otter swimming to S 15' SE of shoreline below Bee House.

10:15 A.M. 31 common merganser in front Bee House

10:30 A.M. a boat from Oregon City, Juneau, Alaska anchored N side Leo Reef, dove for 5 minutes, then repeated at Little and Big Flower Rocks and then beacon out from S end runway on Blokely Island.

6:45 A.M. One group of fishing birds in area of approx. 20' x 20' consisted of:

18 double-crested cormorant

6 common mergansers

13 glaucous-winged gulls

5 red-throated loon

5 common murre.

1:10 P.M. adult bald eagle on beacon of Leo Reef, 11 harbor seal, no other birds. Later a ^{American} crow arrived and alighted 6' from eagle. It ^(crow) remained 4 minutes and then left beacon.

The following birds have been in sound in front of Bee House for practically 95% of the time.

double-crested cormorants, singles to group of 30.

pelagic cormorants, singles to groups of 8.

common mergansers, singles to group of 32

hooded mergansers, singles to group of 3

glaucous-winged gulls, singles to 20 dispersed individuals.

mew gulls, singles to groups of 10

red-necked loon, singles to groups of 5.

common murre, singles to groups of 5

bald eagle, 1 to groups of 3.
