

- 12:40 now reverse direction and going S. around Flat Point.
 12:44 Reversed direction and now passing Round Point.
 12:46 Passing π around Dissected Point.
 12:47 Put out Cove Point but immediately back in water
 12:48 By pass Spring Cove to Tide Point, thence NE.
 12:54 Passing below Bee House going π
 12:57 Passing Boundary Point.

1:45 P.M. Immature bald eagle alighted on rock directly below Bee House. It investigated 2 legs of a starfish (leg 6" long) but did not consume. Two photos of this eagle.

880209-2 and 880209-3 It left 2 minutes later and flew to Lichen Point Tree where it alighted half way up tree. Remained 20 minutes then left to S.

2:20 P.M. The emergent, ^{time of} gates of tidal pool below Bee House can be compared to Leo Reef Rock no 10 and no 11. Rock π side gate = no 10 and rock S side tidal pool = no 11.

4:42 P.M. 14 harbor seal on Leo Reef. 21 double-crested cormorant on Leo Reef Rocks 10 and 11. no 9 not exposed at low tide today. no gulls on Flower Island.

6:00 P.M. Ram, a mule δ deer still carries deformed antlers

Feb. 10, 1988

To Mt. Vernon. while waiting for ferry at terminal (Lopez) noted an adult bald eagle circling π end. Upright, ^{head} at 9:10 A.M. and at 9:31 A.M. an immature bald eagle circling same area.

Feb. 11, 1988

11:30 ^{A.M.} 3 river otter swam and hunted in front Bee House as they swam NE along shoreline

2:25 Sharp-shinned hawk in lower branches of Douglas fir NE (30') from Bee House. It left out over water then back to mainland near Boundary Point.

Feb. 12, 1988

From sun up. 7:42:16, cleared top tree 7:45:13 or 2 mi 57 sec diameter.

From sun up to 4:00 A.M. 3 to 7 eagles at Lichen Point. at one time 3 on rocks, 2 in trees (1 at 1/2 way up Lichen Pt tree, and 1 in Douglas fir nearest shoreline. 2 others in air circling.
