

2:30 P.M. 13 harbor seal on Leo Reef. also 1 adult bald eagle on beacon and no other birds. Also one adult bold eagle on highest prominent bare rock <sup>of Flower Island</sup> and 10 glaucous-winged gulls on S end and N end of same island.

6:15 A.M. first bald eagle (imm) flew S at 50' above water in front of Bee House, turned and trended W at Lichen Point.

6:18 A.M. second imm bald eagle to S. in front Bee House.

6:23 A.M. 2 adult bald eagles flying S in front Bee House none beyond up to 7:15 A.M.

7:19:55 Sun up (top sun even with top of lone tree).
