2:00 P.M. 3 hooded mergansers and 1 ♀ red-breasted merganser in one group that remained together for at least 3/4 hour in front Bee House.

Informed that sea cucumbers, in area of sunken oil barge at Anaortes Ferry Terminal, had oil in digestive tract but not beyond that organ system. The sea urchin had drops of oil throughout its systems.

3:00 P.M. 2 adult bald eagles on separate bare rocks on top of Flower Island. E side. No glaucous-winged gulls on island. Fifteen minutes later, no change. 3:35 P.M. Both eagles left original perches and alighted together on ^{top of} middle section of ridge. No gulls on island. 3:15 P.M. 2 bald eagles back in original position (of 3:00 P.M.) 2 gulls on island
