

march 30, 1988

Observed a single ♂ rufous hummingbird on six different occasions at feeder (which have been in place for 1 week), the last one at 6:35 P.M. This is the first hummingbird observed this spring.

6:00 P.M. A small harbor seal (approx. 5'1/2' long) approached rocks below Bee House, stood on one a raised upper body out of water then slid back into water. It did not investigate 6 8" herring fish placed on bank to attract river otter.

6:30 P.M. 8 glaucous-winged gulls arrived and immediately cleaned up herring from bank.

9:05 A.M. a large Steller sea lion moved N past Bee House at approx 150' from shore. It averaged 10 seconds under water and 4 seconds on surface of water. It moved straight forward and did not appear to be fishing. The day is overcast and no white-caps.

10:05 Left Lopez for Anacortes. Will keep list of birds: 1 glaucous-winged gull, 1 glaucous-winged gull, 1 mew gull. Rarely see birds perching on white wall of W side Willaw Island. W end Thatcher Pass. 1 double-crested cormorant, 4 pelagic cormorant. E end Thatch Pass. 2 glaucous-winged gulls, 3 pigeon gullmots, 1 glaucous-winged gull, 1 double-crested cormorant, 2 pelagic cormorant, 1 glaucous-winged cormorant. Arrived Anacortes ferry terminal. Observed a ^{american} crow chase a common roven and dove 6 times.

Left Anacortes ferry terminal. In bay to S of ferry terminal observed 142 mew gulls, 8 glaucous-winged gulls and 8 double-crested cormorant on ^{poles} at W end of bay. Also in area were 8 buffleheads, 2 common mergansers, 5 pelagic cormorant, 3 horned grebes and 2 double-crested cormorant. Begin ferry trip. 2 western grebes, 1 mew gull, 2 pelagic cormorant, 3 pigeon gullmots, 3 pelagic cormorants, 1 glaucous-winged gull, mew gull, glaucous-winged gull, mew gull. E end Thatcher Pass, 2 glaucous winged gulls, 2 glaucous-winged gulls, mew gull. W end Thatcher Pass, 2 glaucous-winged gulls, 2 glaucous-winged gulls, double-crested cormorant, 3 pigeon gullmots,
