

Washington Lake then return, at 2300 RPM (maximum) some smoke from gasket, outlet on top motor and other things that can be corrected. Along route observed: western grebes, double-crested cormorants, glaucous-winged gulls, mallards, coots, Canada geese. Return to Chris home on Lost Lake.

April 19, 1988

motor inspection 9:10 AM by Don of Galley marine, N end Union Lake. 1 and 5 piston slightly weaker than others but do not need repair. 4 or 5 minor problems easily corrected including leaks from hose connections. Motor good in general and he would not be willing to take boat to Mexico and return. \$500 for replacement of motor.

Left marina and returned to Lopez, enroute checked tulip fields in Shagit Valley and they are in full blossom. Redtailed hawk at McDeon and LaConner roads. Continued to Anacortes ferry terminal. In bay to S noted: 8 bufflehead, 10 surf scoters, 80 mew gulls, 85 glaucous-winged gulls, 4 double-crested cormorant, 2 pelagic cormorant, 10 western grebes. Left ferry terminal on ferry at 5:23 PM. Tidal currents. Enroute: 18 pigeon guillemots, 4 horned grebes, 5 surf scoters, 4 surf scoters. Across Rosario Straits: 3 pelagic cormorants, 1 glaucous-winged gull, 2 pigeon guillemots, James Island, 2 pigeon guillemots, 1 harbor seal, Pointe Island glaucous-winged gull on territories approx. 3 1/2 ft apart. E. Thatcher Pass, 3 pigeon guillemots, 2 pigeon guillemots, 3 rhinoceros auklets, 3 pigeon guillemots, 2 rhinoceros auklets, 2 rhinoceros auklets, 2 pigeon guillemots (all mainly E end Thatcher Pass). W Thatcher Pass 2 glaucous-winged gulls, no birds on white washed cliffs of Willow Island, glaucous-winged gulls, pelagic cormorant, horned grebe. At Lopez dock 8 glaucous-winged gulls, 4 pelagic cormorants. our replenished
at Bee house, deer returned to feeder after 2 1/2 hrs of our arrival.
