

- 4:02 P.M. mammai deer, a mule deer (matriarch) at ♂ of last years young of feeder and measured 28 1/2" high at shoulders.
- 6:00 P.M. while cutting (sawing (hand)) wood at Bee House a black shrew past directly beneath log while cutting was in operation. as it passed pipe of subduct on a slope, it had difficulty navigating
- 6:20 P.M. a ♂ mule deer of last years feed at feeder. It measured 27 1/2" at shoulders. The antlers were just exposed above the hair.
- 6:30 P.M. 140 gannet-winged gulls on territories on Flower Island.
- 6:30 P.M. to 7:00 P.M. a Common loon in summer plumaged fed in front of Bee House in localized area.
- 6:34. Belted Kingfisher in Spring Cave bordering Bee Estate.
- 6:35 1 rufous hummingbird at feeder (Bee House). On April 10, 1988 there were 9-13 individuals at the same feeder and same time of day.
- 8:25 Two rufous hummingbirds of Bee House feeder. they both left at 8:28 P.M. at late twilight

April 21, 1988

- 1:10 A.M. ♀ mule deer measuring 28 1/4" at shoulder at Bee feeder.
- 1:15 small ♀ mule deer of last year measured 25" at shoulders
- 1:20 A.M. with more sunshine, ^{brown linear} aquatic vegetation is growing from 1' to 3' in height deciduous trees on W side Blahely, directly E of us, now yellowish-green but more green than yellow. mad-rona on Bee Estate from beginning to full blossom thus:
- Inflorescence
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 ○○○○○ green buds
 ○○○○○ } white bells.
 ○○○○○ } bells dropped from tree and covering ground below
- To rufous hummingbirds today. The hummingbirds may be feeding on natural inflorescence of trees etc, instead of at feeder, where the average number is 2.
