



at sunrise fog developed on ridge of Blakely and below Round Peak in seven minutes

6:30 a single rufous hummingbird flew straight up from porch level of Bee House to 35 feet & return. Later two rufous hummingbirds performed the same action together.

6:42 ad. bald eagle flew S past Bee House.

April 27, 1988

To Anacortes and mt Vernon for <sup>inspection of</sup> last 2 melanoma nodules in forehead. Left Lopez ferry terminal 10:10 A.M. overcast, water calm. As we passed N end Lopez Island two eagles on nest. Leo Reef 2 glaucous winged gulls, no harbor seal, W Thatcher Pass, 2 Bonaparte gulls, 3 Bonaparte gulls, 1 Bonaparte gull, E Thatcher Pass, 9 Bonaparte gulls one group on water, 2 pigeon gull nests, 1 Bonaparte gull, 1 glaucous-winged gull, 2 pigeon gull nests, 8 Bonaparte gulls, 2 glaucous-winged gulls. Arrived Anacortes ferry terminal. Spent night at La Conner Thousand Trails Preserve.

April 28, 1988.

In lagoon at Lone Tree Point at T.T. noted: 5 ♀ bufflehead, 1 double-crested cormorant, 3 glaucous-wing gulls, 8 American crows, 2 belted kingfishers.

at reefs S of Lone Tree Point noted: 8 greater scaups, 32 greater scaups, 8 common goldeneye, 4 and 12 double crested cormorants, 7 glaucous-winged gulls, 8 american crows. American robin and pileated woodpecker in camp (at drainage entering lagoon).

Left for Bellingham from T.T. at 11:08 A.M. Spent day there (Bellingham) and returned in evening at mt. Vernon Thousand Trails Preserve. at Bow Hill N of Burlington.
