

At Bee House, at 7:30 P.M. 3 river otter swam 5 and 30' from shore.

7:35 P.M. Sister, a mule deer measured 28" at shoulders.

May 14, 1988

Floria and Bob Williams arrived for week end.

May 15, 1988

10:10 A.M. 3 Orea approx 300' E Leo Reef moving N.

2:00 P.M. 32 band-tailed pigeons at front porch feeder at Bee House.

3:20 P.M. Harbor seal returning to Leo Reef and rocks of Flower Island. On Leo Reef 12 harbor seal, 6 on Little Flower Rock, 7 on north Flower Rock, Annette took photos of The Bee (a boat)

May 16, 1988

8:20 A.M. 2 adult bald eagles on Big Flower Rock. Glaucous-winged gulls remained on Flower Island. One half hour later they moved to lower rocks on Flower Island.

11:30 A.M. 18 mallards, 4 godwits, 3 pintails, 1 shoveller in Swifts Lagoon.

12:45 P.M. 17 harbor seal on Leo Reef, three of which were dark and large and the others grayish with spots; 15 harbor seal on Little Flower Rock, 8 whitish gray + 7 dark; 2 on 70 10 Rock of Leo Reef.

4:00 P.M. 2 river otter resting on aft platform of The Bee (Grand Banks boat)

4:35 captured a *Peromyscus m. hallisteri* from Bee House:

880516-1 *Peromyscus m. hallisteri* 184-77-22-19-31 gms, ♀.

This afternoon placed anchor buoy in Shoal Bay
