June 11, 1988

8:30 A.M. 2 common raven feed on cracked corn & wheat at bird feeder at Bee House.

A shy ♀ mule deer, 30 1/2" at shoulders at feeder of Bee House.
 6 Eastern gray squirrels on front porch feeder, at one time.
 Following ♂ mule deer at Bee feeder at one time



This 34" high buck left feeder to trail to NE corner Joyce Fralic home, thence across her yard patio then up drive way. In 20' later it returned, passing 10' below lower parking lot
