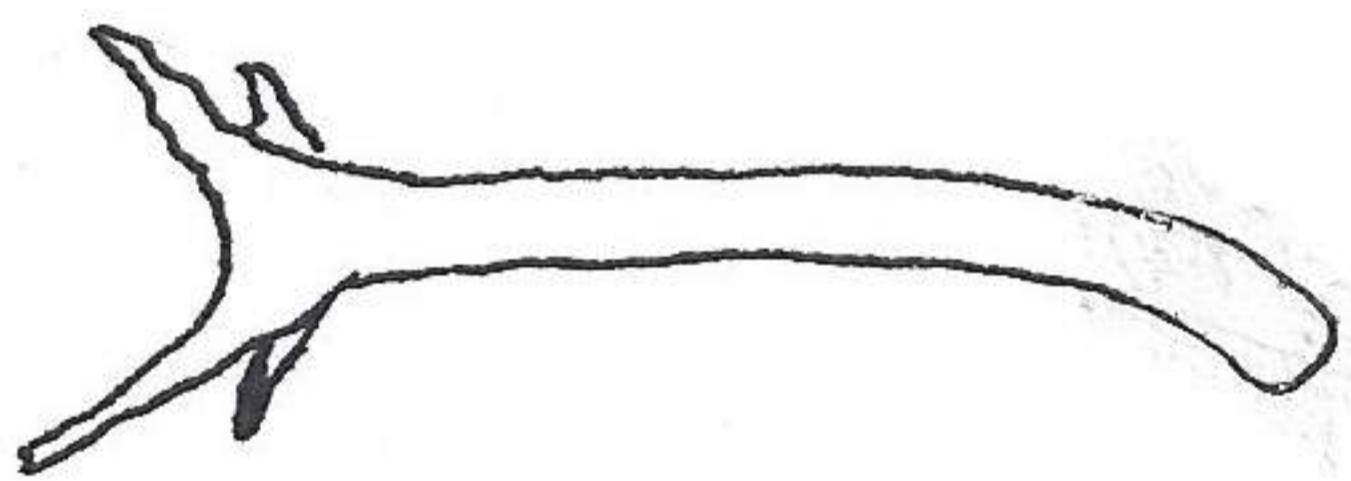
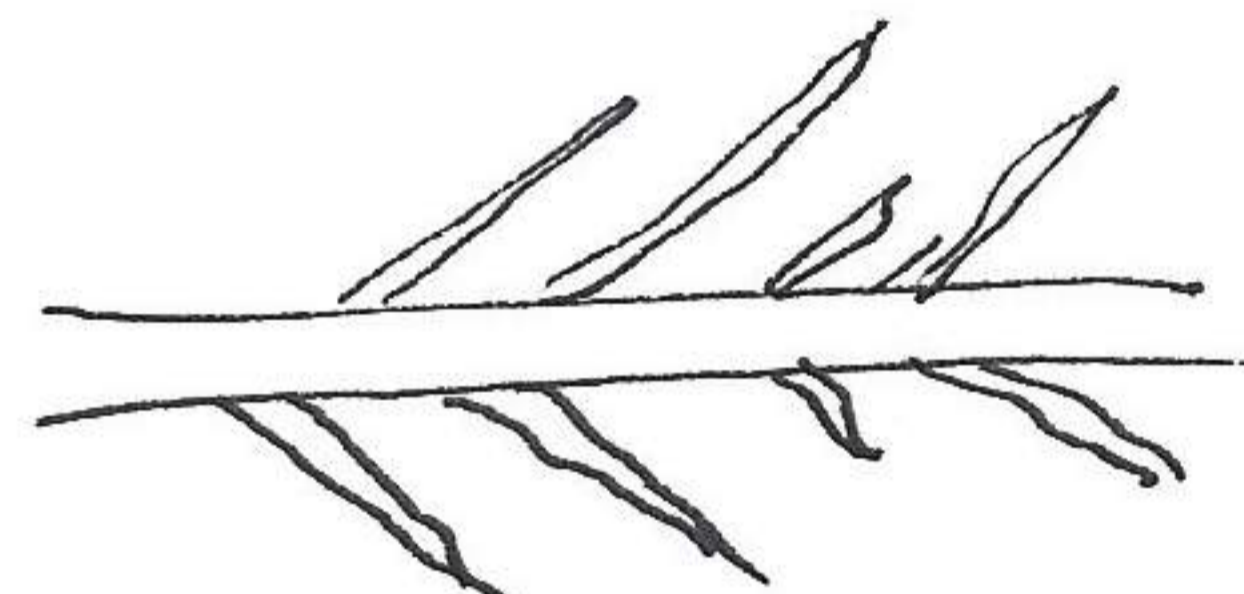


10:30 A.M. 34 harbor seal on Leo Reef, none elsewhere.
