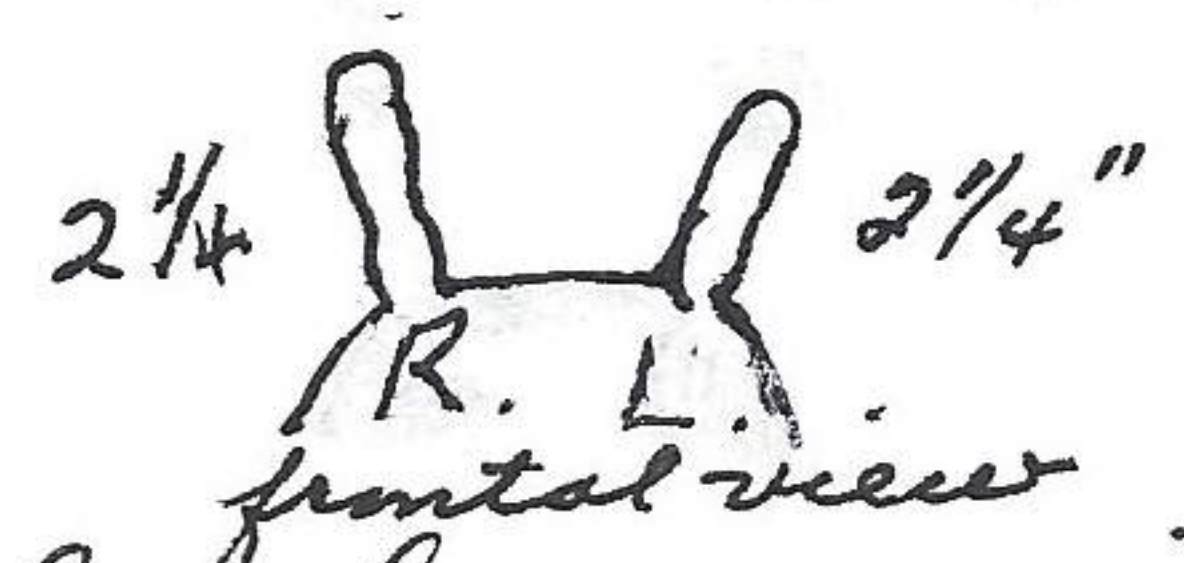


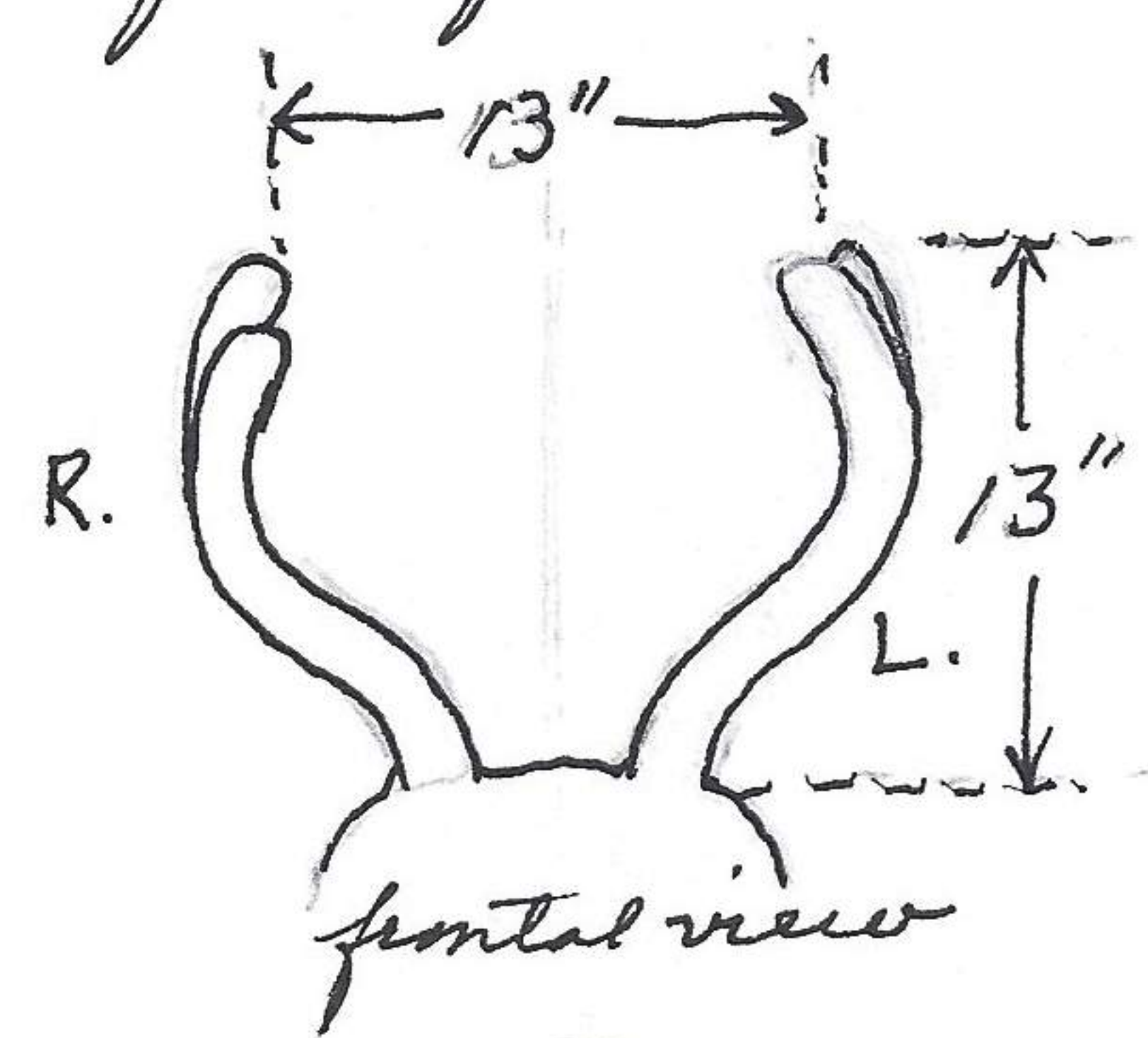

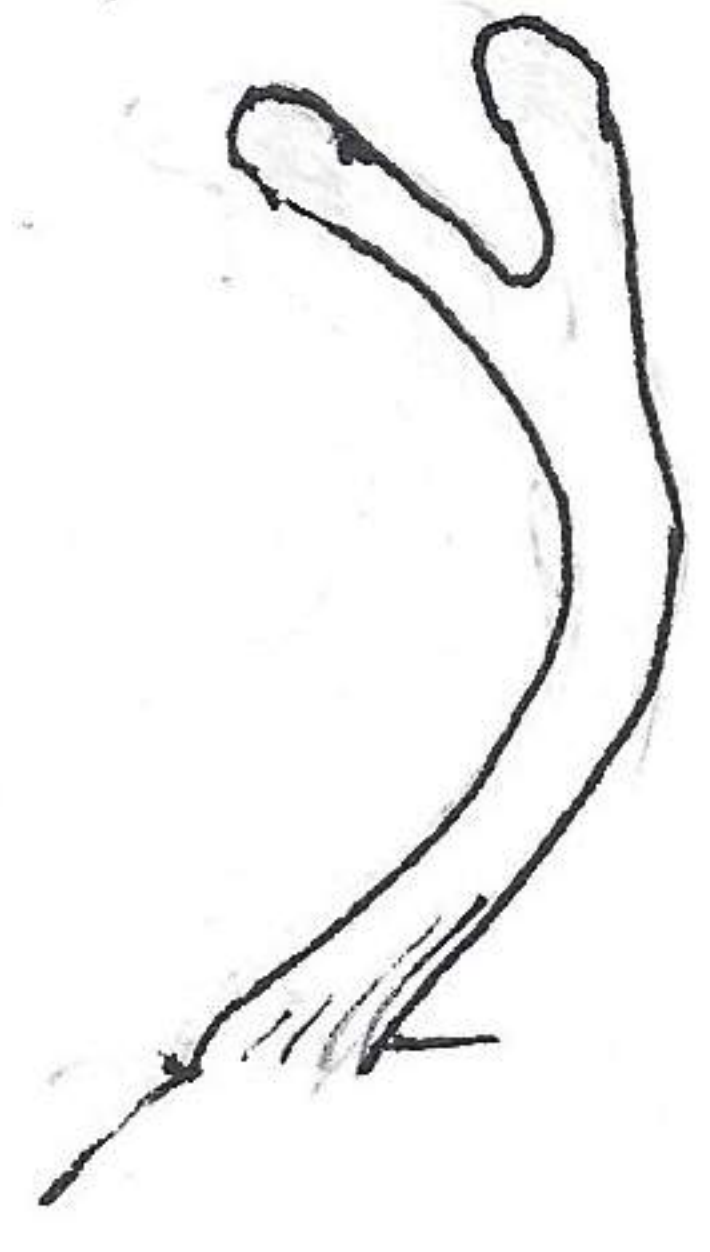
♂ mule deer, 30" high at shoulders, left antler shorter than right one.



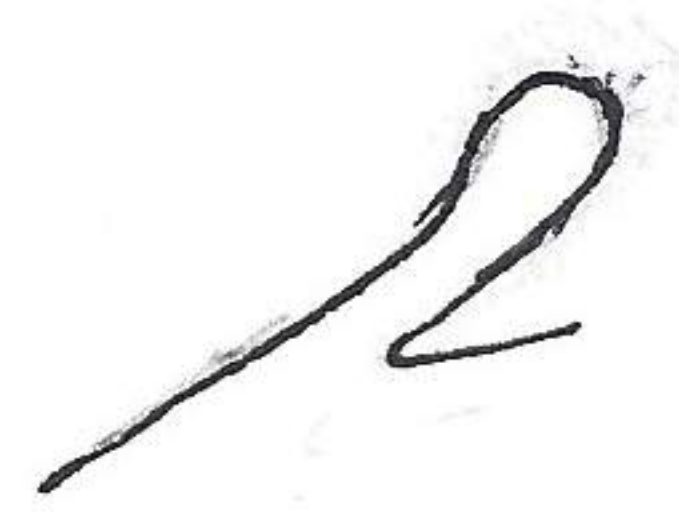
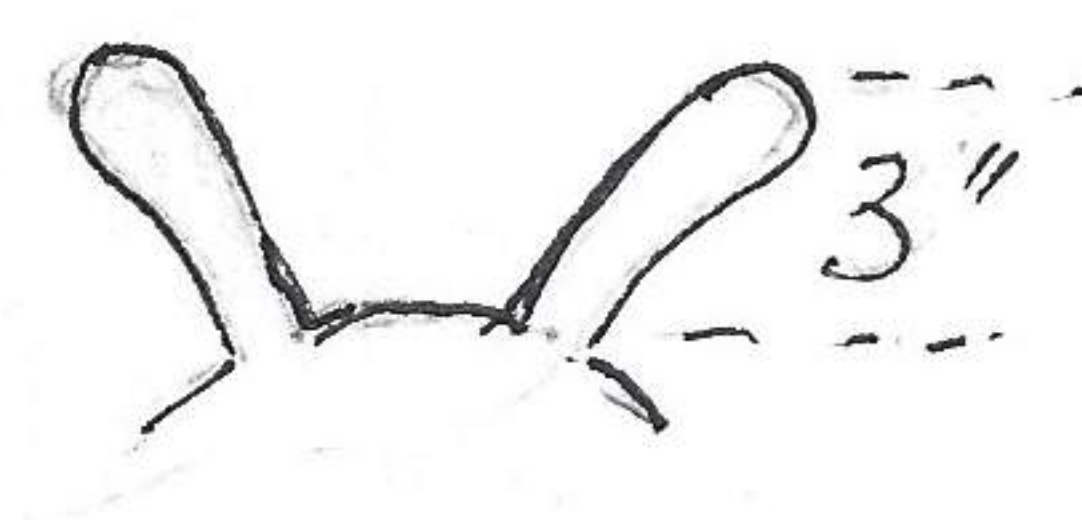
Watched Eastern gray squirrel forcefully chase American crow from feeder.



at 7:45 P.M. male mule deer at feeder and first time observed. It was moderately tame and our movements in kitchen, 7 feet distance, did not disturb its feeding. Buck did not have tines 34" high at shoulder.



This buck fed for 12 minutes on cracked corn and wheat and then left to top of cliff via E trail, thence up slope to top of stairs then deer trail between two large Douglas fir to meadow.
