Left 9:41 am. for Anacortes. while passing Leo Reef noted 22 harbor seal on N side only. 5 harbor seal on Little Flower Island, W end Thatcher Pass. Glaucous-winged gull, 2 marbled murrelet at E Thatcher Pass. 9 marbled murrelets in one flock. 10:16 Arrived Anacortes ferry terminal, 4 glaucous-winged gulls at ferry proper, others in bay to SW.
