No bald eagle on nest at N end Humphrey Head.

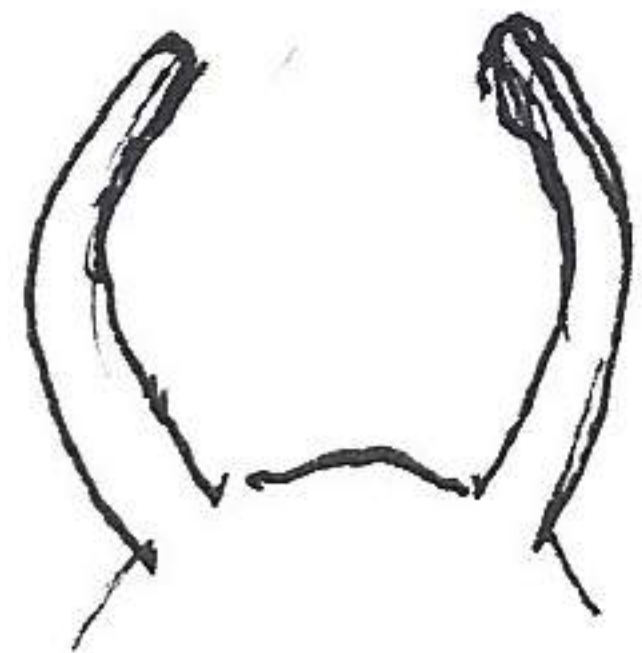
32 glaucous-winged gulls on piling at Lopez Island Ferry terminal. Arrived about sundown.

A fawn of a pair of a ♀ mother had an abscess.

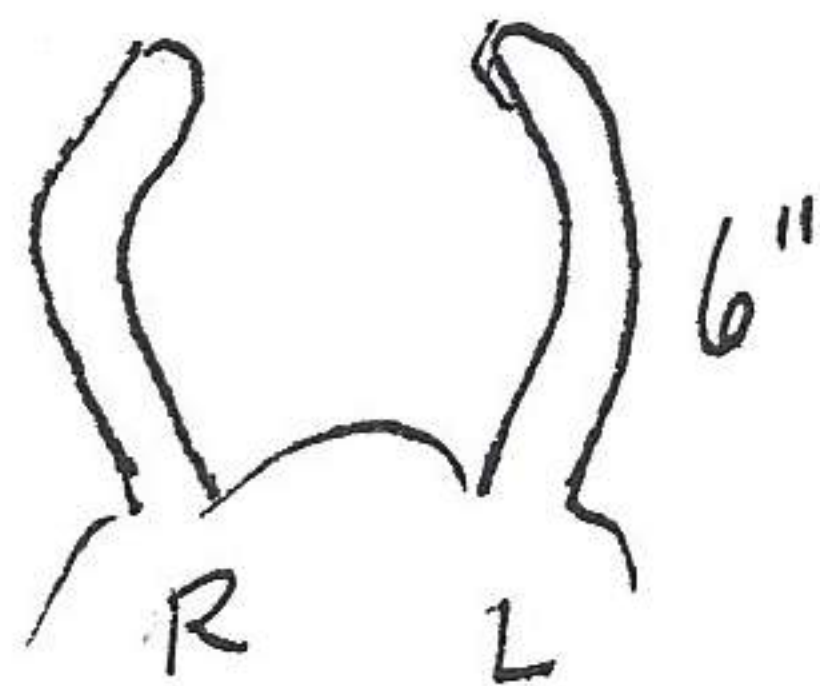
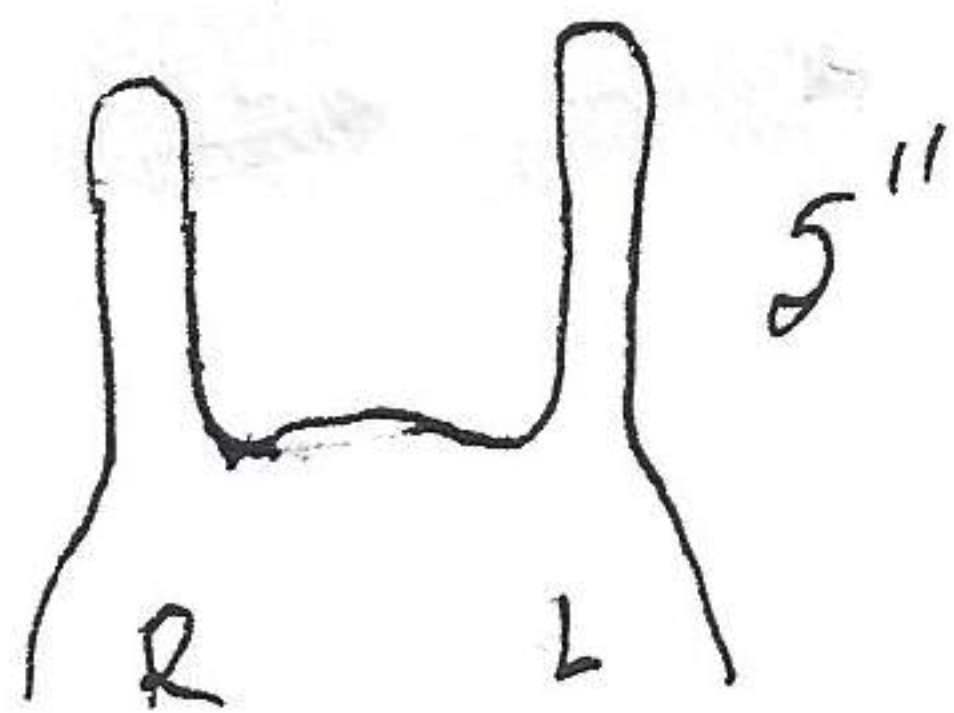
