




Another male <sup>mule</sup> deer similar to above and measured 30" high at shoulders with antlers  and side view  Left tear duct enlarged and gouge of hair on left hind quarters. Timed.

Aug. 8, 1988

880808-8 *Peromyscus m. hallisteri* 165-75-22-17-19gms ♂ testes 6mm skull only. From Bee House.

88080808-9 *Peromyscus m. hallisteri* 180-86-23-17-22gms. ♀ ut. normal. skull only. From Bee House.

One of the male mule deer with symmetrical antlers  fed at feeder with ad ♀ mule deer. They groomed each others neck and head.

Bats active twilight last night and at daybreak this A.M. Noted increase number shorebirds at SW end Shoal Bay.

Aug. 9, 1988

This A.M. at Swifts Lagoon noted 62 sanderling, 5 lesser yellow legs and 8 western sandpipers.

At the Low Beach Swifts Bay watched an osprey hover 5 times, then on the 6th dropped almost straight down from 60' and captured a fish (9" long). It flew W toward middle of island after flying N to Humphrey Lagoon.

Have observed 4 turkey vultures on trip to Lopez Village.

Spent evening on The Bee (a grand banks boat) in S end Shoal Bay approx. 10 mi. SW Humphrey Head Marina. Caught 1 spiny dogfish <sup>22 mm</sup> *Squalus acanthias*; 2 Pacific Cod measuring; (*Gadus macrocephalus*):

Buster, a mule deer and her fawn (23" high at shoulders) fed at feeder. I have not observed Buster with a fawn before. The fawn was lighter than other fawns and was losing its spots. Buster chased one of the curved spined mates  and then left feeder. The fawn followed Buster and twice nursed from Buster. They groomed each other on neck and head areas.
