

The male mule deer with straight and parallel antlers ~~11~~ has been associated with a ♀ of same size or perhaps slightly smaller. They frequently groom each other on the neck and head.

(Grand Banks)

This evening went to Bee boat (hence will be referred to 'The Bee' in journal). Two harbor seal fished approx 150' NW of outlet of Humphrey Lagoon. Observed at least 10 times in 2 hours. Two single great blue heron flew S over marina and thence to Swifts Bay via Humphrey Lagoon.

Aug. 10, 1988

To Anacortes by ferry. Left 11:40 A.M. Will keep complete list of birds. Bonaparte gull, glaucous-winged gull, no bald eagle on nest at N end Humphrey Head. At Leo Reef, 2 harbor seal on S side reef, 5 on N side. 4 harbor seal on N Flower Rock. At Point Island gulls in normal position on territories, 2 pigeon guillemot on water S of Pomter Island. In Rosario Straits, Bonaparte gull, group 2 glaucous-winged gull, glaucous-winged gull, pigeon hawk flew S past ferry, 11 pigeon guillemots one group, 4 Bonaparte gulls, 9 pigeon guillemots. Arrived Anacortes ferry terminal.

Aug 13, 1988

On return from Chris at Lost Lake, noted red-tailed hawk at Starwood Turnoff.

At Best road and no. 20 highway (NE in field) observed a whirlwind 30' in diameter and traveled 200' without interruption.

At 'The Bee' max temp. in cabin last week 104° max and 58° min. Greatest tilt from ferry wake 12½°. Takes 22 min. for waves to reach the boat in the S end of Shoal Bay from channel approaching Lopez Ferry Terminal.

Aug 14, 1988

This evening 5:40 P.M. at 'The Bee' caught spiny dogfish shark 37" standard length. Also one tree cod 6" standard length.

Aug. 16, 1988

23 harbor seal on Leo Reef this A.M. Also 2 on Little Flower Rock and 5 on North Flower Rock. Rain today and first this summer.
