 Estate

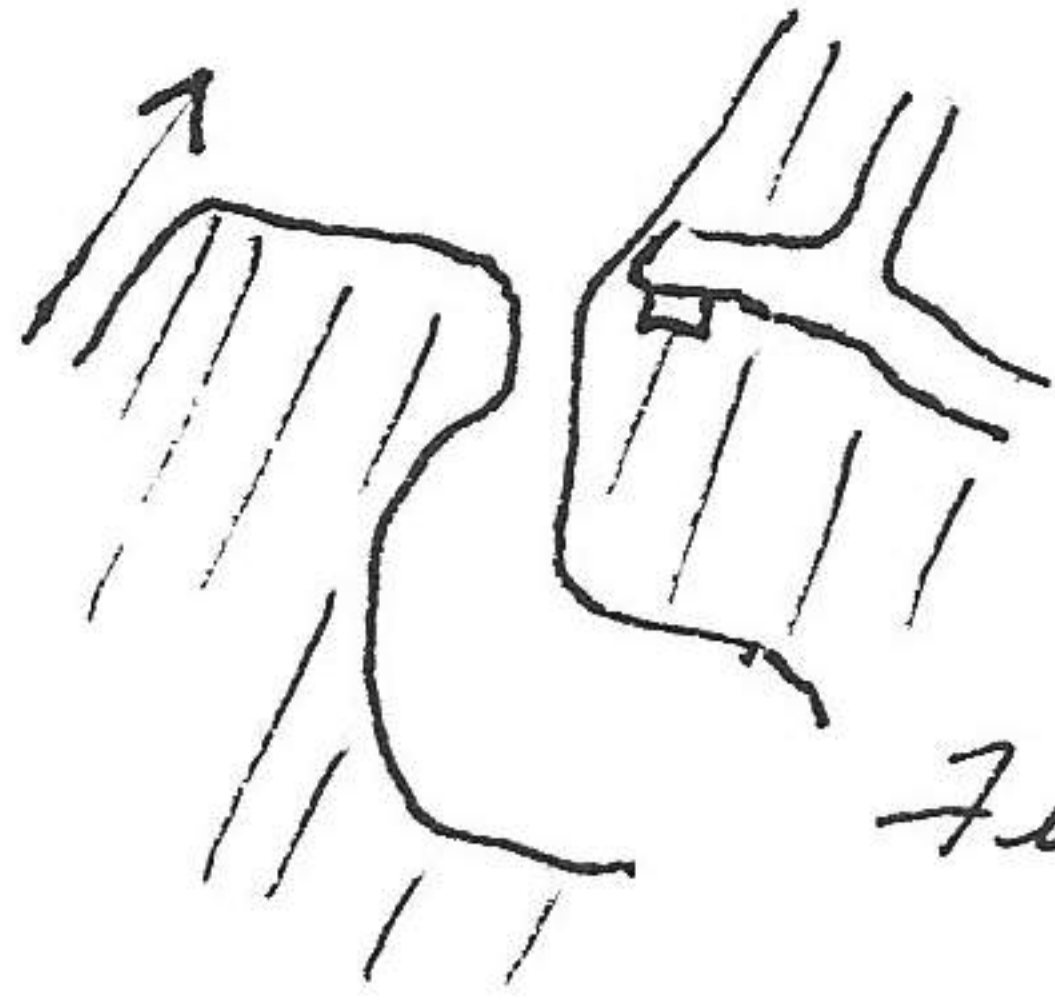
Spent evening on 'The Bee' and caught 4 true cod 6'1/2", 4'1/2",

 bald eagle top tree by edge of water 1/10 mi E of only residence
 on n end Aleator. E end Thatcher Pass 6 Bonaparte gulls.
 Beyond fog bank to Anacortes. at Anacortes ferry: double-
 crested cormorant, 28 glaucous-winged gulls + 4 Bonaparte gulls
 Left Anacortes on return trip to Lopez. First 3rd of
 trip across Rosario Straits observed: 3 glaucous-winged gulls,
 Bonaparte gull, double-crested cormorant, Bonaparte gull, 2 Heermanns
