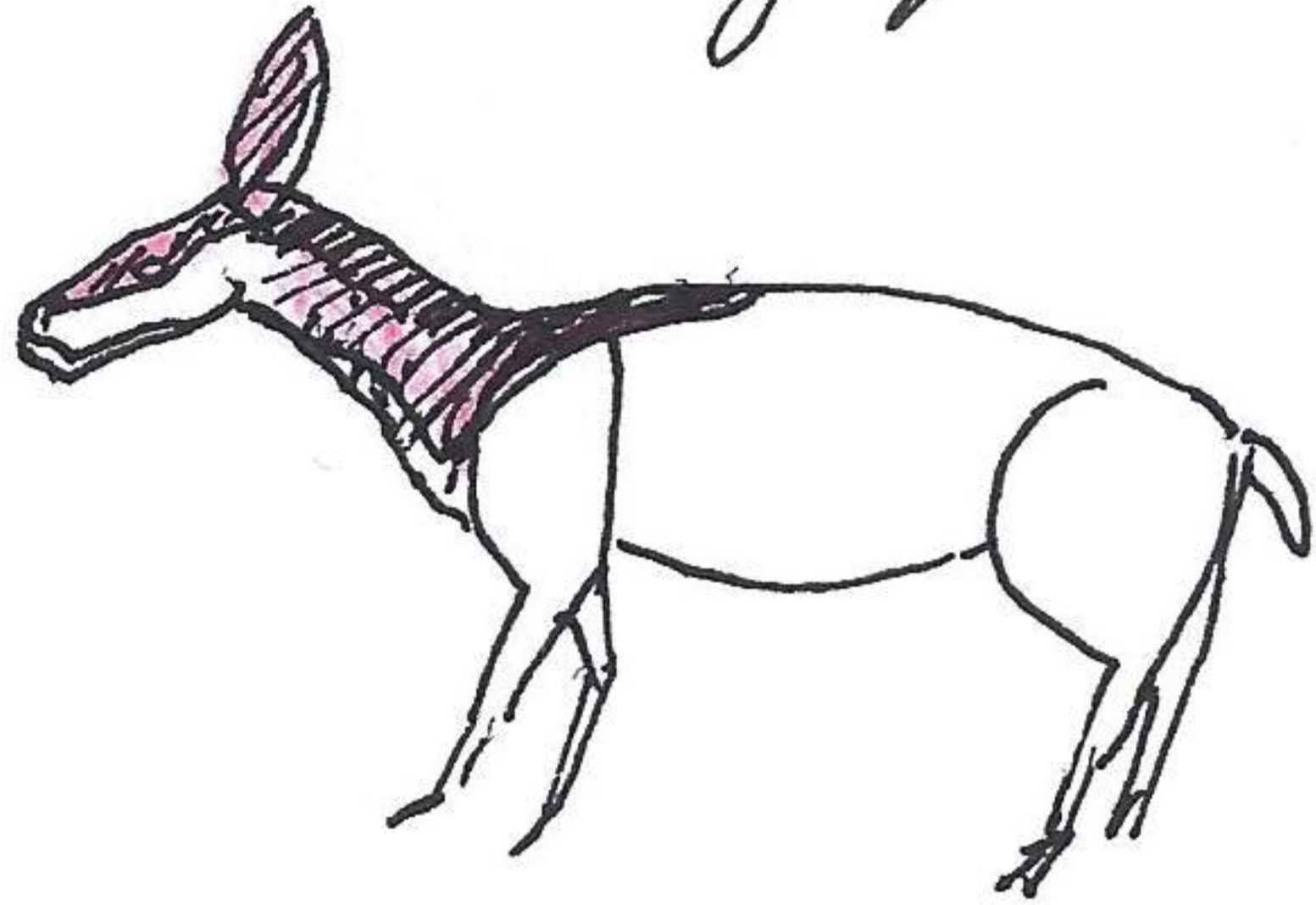


gulls, 2 single pigeon guillemots, 2 pigeon guillemots, pigeon guillemots, double-crested cormorant. 5:23 P.M. E Thatcher Pass  
 glaucous-winged gull, 4 glaucous-winged gulls, 2 Bonaparte gulls.  
 W end Thatcher Pass. Willow Island, a glaucous-winged gull feeding young on nest in white area of SW corner.  
 Cormorant sp.?, Bonaparte gull. no <sup>bold</sup> eagle on nest N end Humphrey Head.

Aug 19, 1988

♀ mule deer 29" high at shoulders most aggressive deer at feeder and elsewhere.

a fawn mule deer. 22 1/2" high at shoulders, first to start change of pelage. (losing spots and rich color of hair).



Aug. 20, 1988

♀ mule deer <sup>28"</sup> and her two fawns 22 1/2" high at shoulder (largest) of 2 fawns. After all three fed for 10 minutes they left and at 30' out stopped to groom necks & face. The largest of the fawn attempted twice to mount the adult female.

Deer flies, generally one fly per individual deer, harassed the deer. The deer shook skin, shook heads & neck and in several instances left area by running.

This A.M. checked trap in first floor (basement) of Bee House and caught:

August 20, 1988

mule deer  
 2 bucks (antlers spikes and approx 5" long) spared by placing head near or against each others head and pushing with gentle force. One skiddish and would jump backwards in several directions, swing head & necks from side to side and fake forward movements. Also noted 2 adult females at feeder, stand up-right against each other and fight with thrusting front legs.
