

parking lot to S. The goat come to parking lot in evening from slope of canyon to S. At this time groups of young people are rebuilding trails, closing off trail not to be used in the reconstruction and planting bare areas trampled by humans. To put 200-300 people on these parking bordering trails is not realistic. From this area of Painter's Point, ^{and lower down} recorded photos of mt. Baker and Annette 880827-1; mt. and lake in foreground 880827-2; mt. Sucksan from Picture Lake 880827-3

No birds or mammals in this area. The parking lot is size of football field and plans are to pave road from lodge area below to here.

Photo 880727-3 of this lake + S. Left area and returned to Picture Lake. Road N & W of lake a wide 3 lane road, meadows W end lake now confined to trail traffic only with old trails and trampling replanted. A natural succession would have been a better plan.

Left area and drove to Chandellier (E. of Glacier) and stayed in camping area behind. All government campsites taken. In this area were Townsend Chipping (1), American Crow (2). Bird life deperate in the entire N Fork Nooksack drainage, at least from road.

Aug 28, 1988.

Left Chandellier and returned up Canyon to Nooksack Falls where a photo was taken:

880828-1. Note one Douglas Squirrel here. *Tamiasciurus douglasii douglasii*. The orange belly diagnostic.

From here drove to Silver Lake, N of Glacier and camped in no 1 of sec 2. at one of the building used by barn swallows, 10 birds converged and called when we passed by.

Took boat from dock and Camp to N end lake & return. Birds observed; 2 woodchucks, 2 spotted sandpipers, 2 American Crows, 4 barn swallows.

On ridge trail north of Camp:

11 Dusky grouse with area 30' x 20', most of them dusting in dust concretions.
