

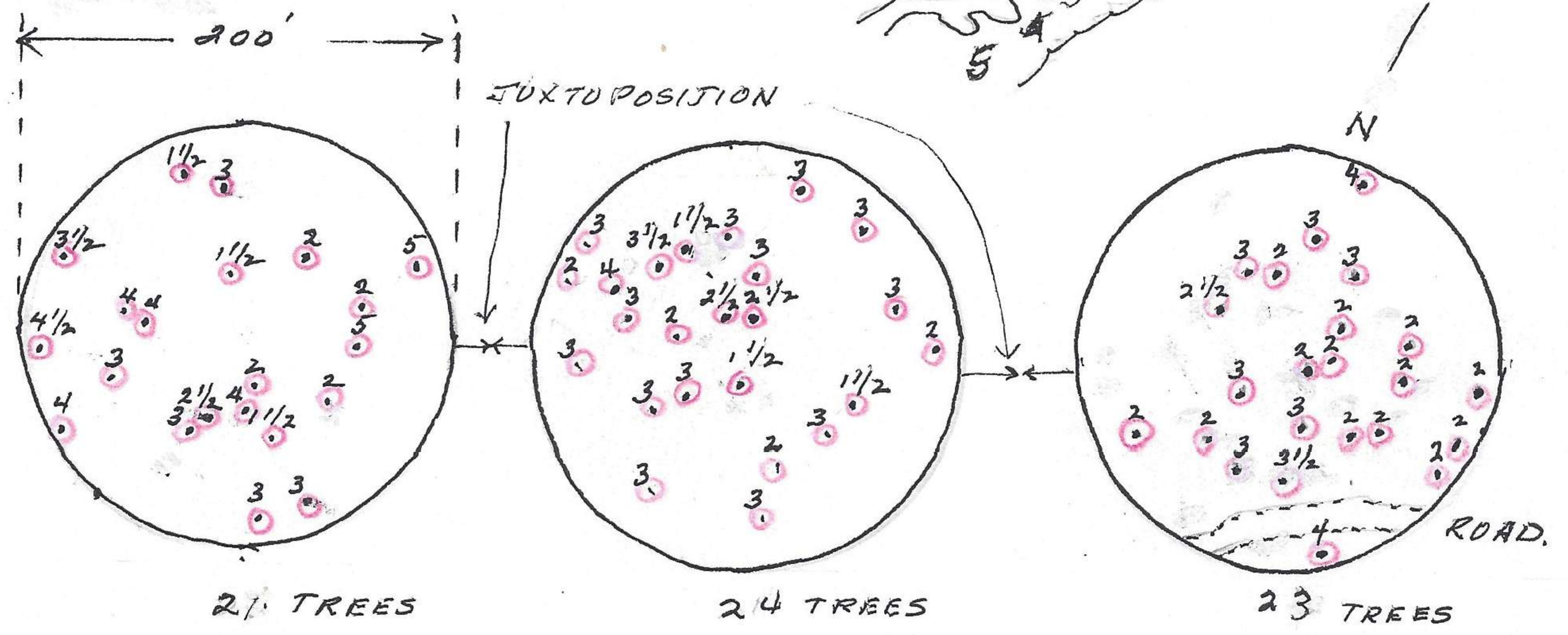
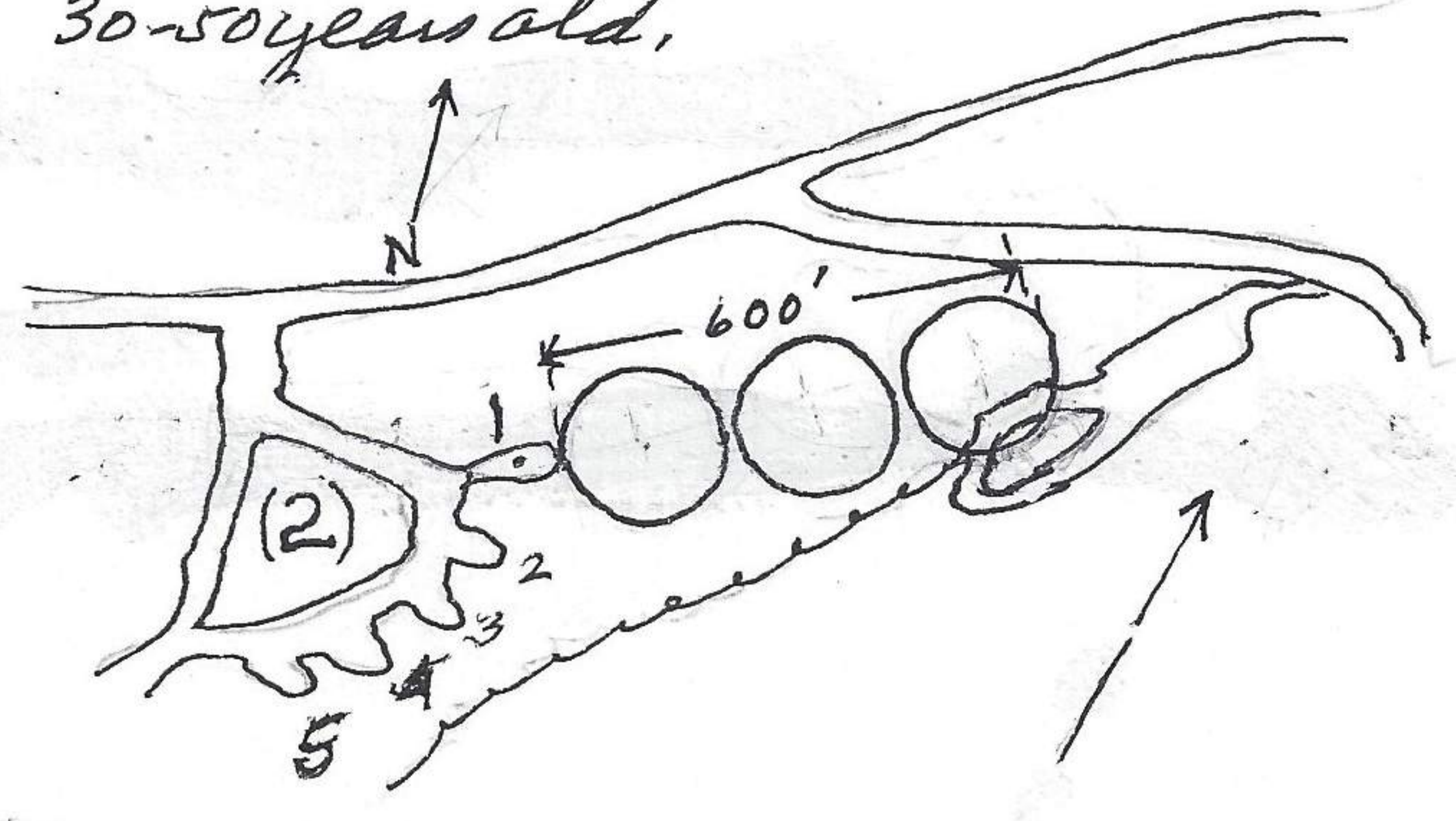
First one left and flew out of sight downhill, 2 more left 20 seconds later but remained in area, 4th bird left area 10 seconds later, 5, 6, 7 bird left, <sup>15 seconds later</sup> and remained in area, 8, 9, 10, left 20 seconds later and remained in area. The last one left 3 seconds later and flew beyond area and out of sight. This area had drow and in deciduous (few conifers) forest and considerable underbrush.

Aug. 29, 1988

A Douglas squirrel churped for 2 minutes at 8' distance from trunk of a hemlock tree. Evidence of worked cones in area.

many holes made by pileated woodpeckers in conifer trees, some fresh and others could be 30-50 years old.

Recorded distribution and diameter of trees cut approx 100 years ago(?). including hemlock, Douglas fir and red cedar.
