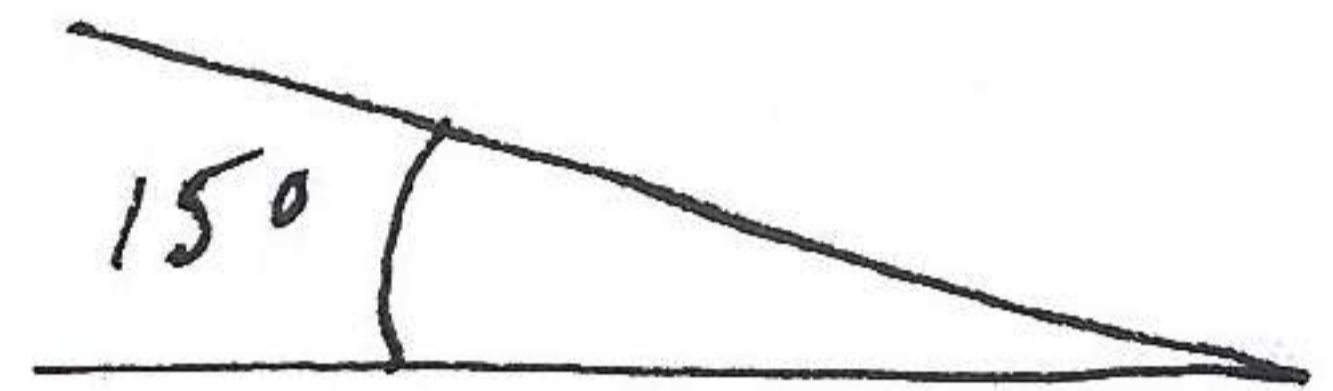


5 small groups. One harbor seal worked area in front of Bee House, out 8' to 50' from, about 12:00 A.M. to 1:45 P.M.

This evening to 'The Bee' in Shoal Bay. Caught 2 dogfish (spiny) measuring 23 and 21 inches in standard length. Watched a Bonaparte gull chase a common tern for 2 mins. The tern had better maneuverability but the gull persisted but without success.

The boat tilted 15° from waves of ferry that passes by $1\frac{2}{10}$ mi. to N. The waves take 22 minutes to arrive at boat at anchor in S end Shoal Bay
