

Bonaparte gull, marbled murrelet, 9 single glaucous-winged gulls, In middle Lasario Straits, 6 groups common murrelets of approx. 10 birds per group. 18 glaucous-winged gulls generally distributed; 12 pigeon guillemots, 7 marbled murrelets, all above <sup>linear</sup> area and 2/10 mile wide. 3 common murrelets, 2 <sup>single</sup> glaucous-winged gulls, Point Fountroy. W Thatcher Pass. Group 12 glaucous-winged gulls E. of Leo Reef. 3 glaucous-winged gulls, 6 common murrelets. Lopez 6:05 P.M. 12 glaucous-winged gulls on piling of Lopez ferry terminal.

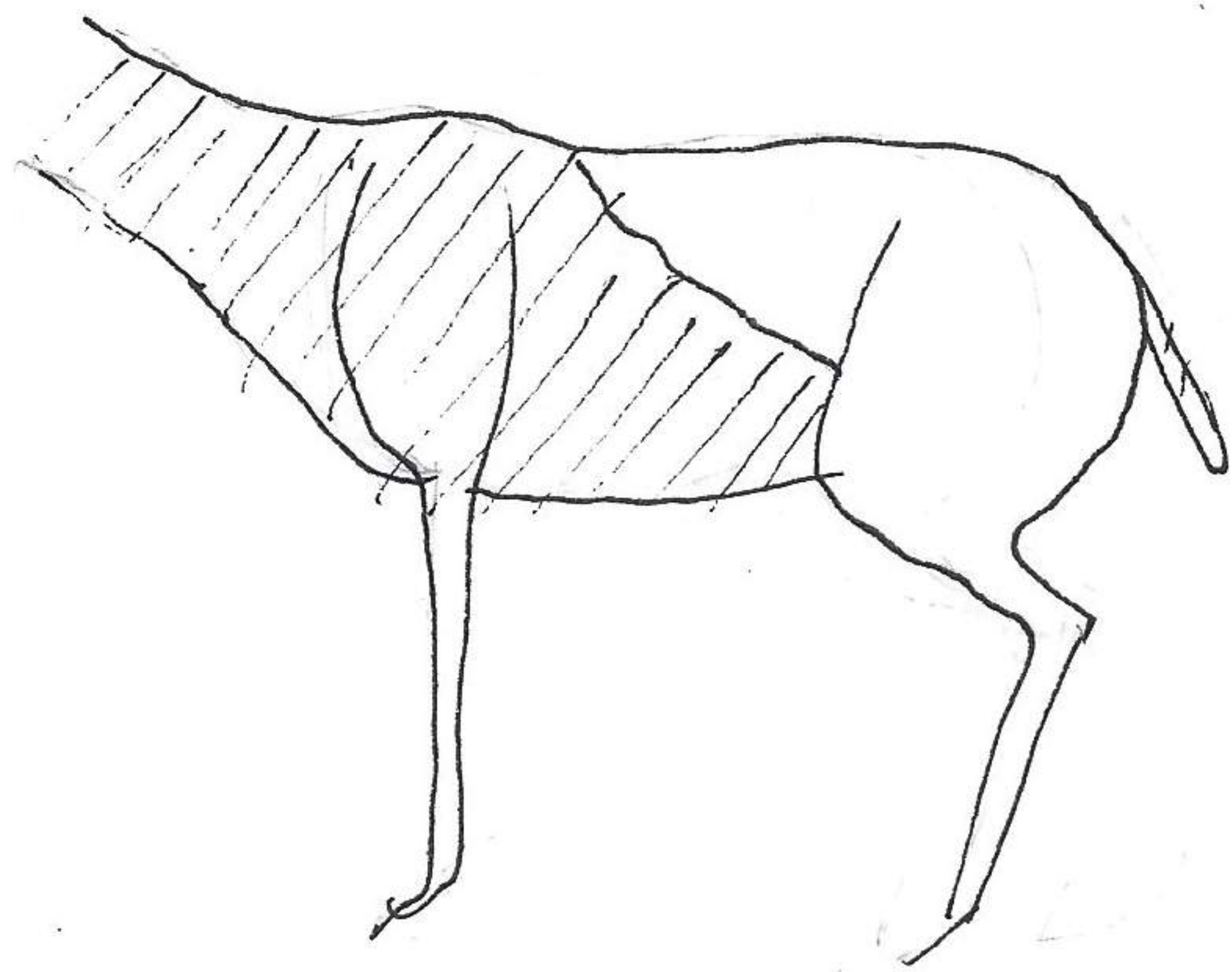

mule deer at feeder:

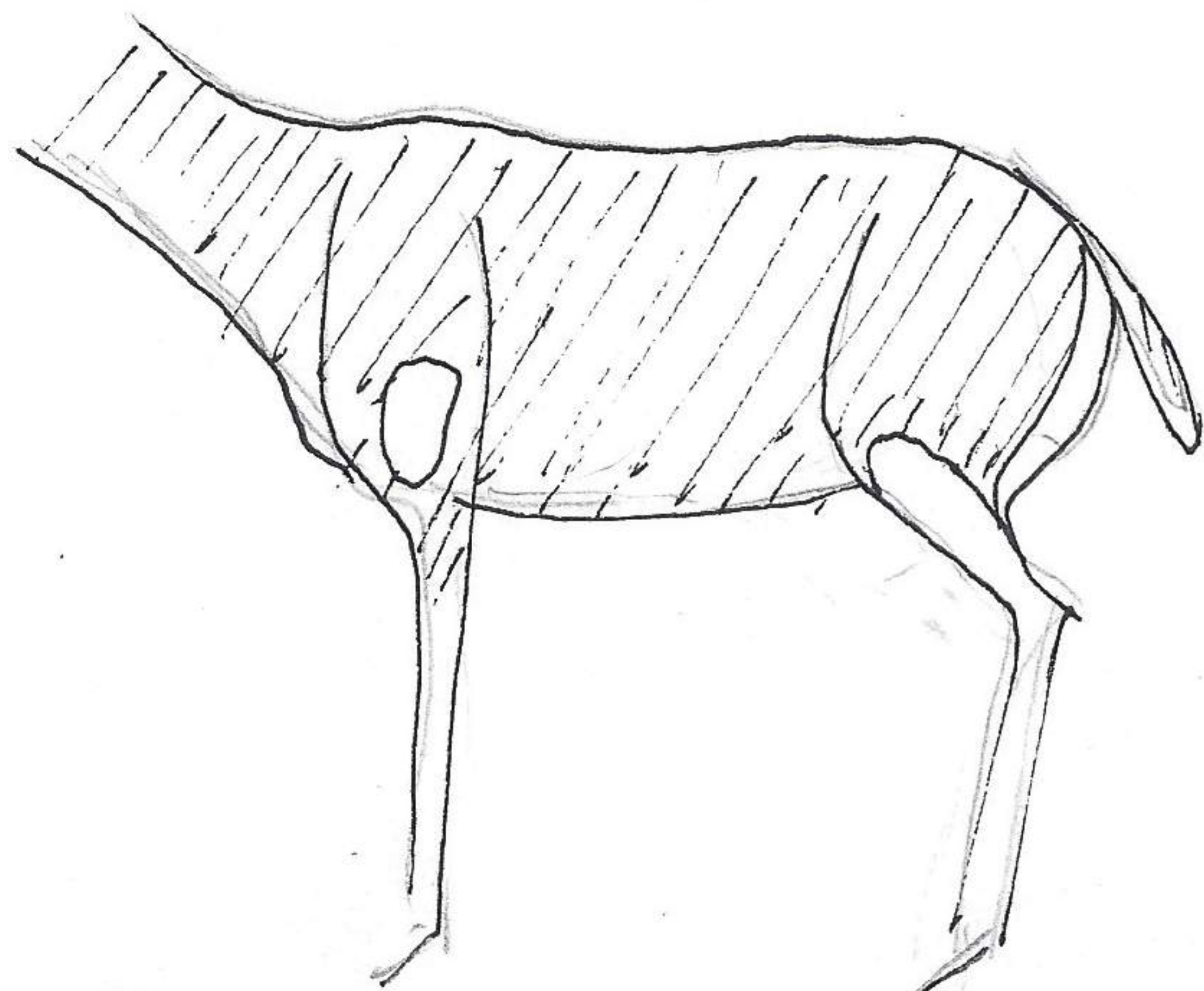
♀ 25 1/2" high at shoulders, pelage (winter) complete.

♀ 29 1/2" high at shoulders, mother of above and complete pelage change. Both have faint spots adjacent medial back line.

10:10 A.M. 5 river otter to NE past Bee House (one group)  
Red-billed grebe in Spring Cove and sleeps 80% of the time



mule deer ♀ 28" high at shoulder showing pelage change from summer to winter (striped new pelage)
