Leons mane common in Haro Straits. Continued to Victoria on Vancouver Island and parked overnight parking on town town parking area. (at docks).

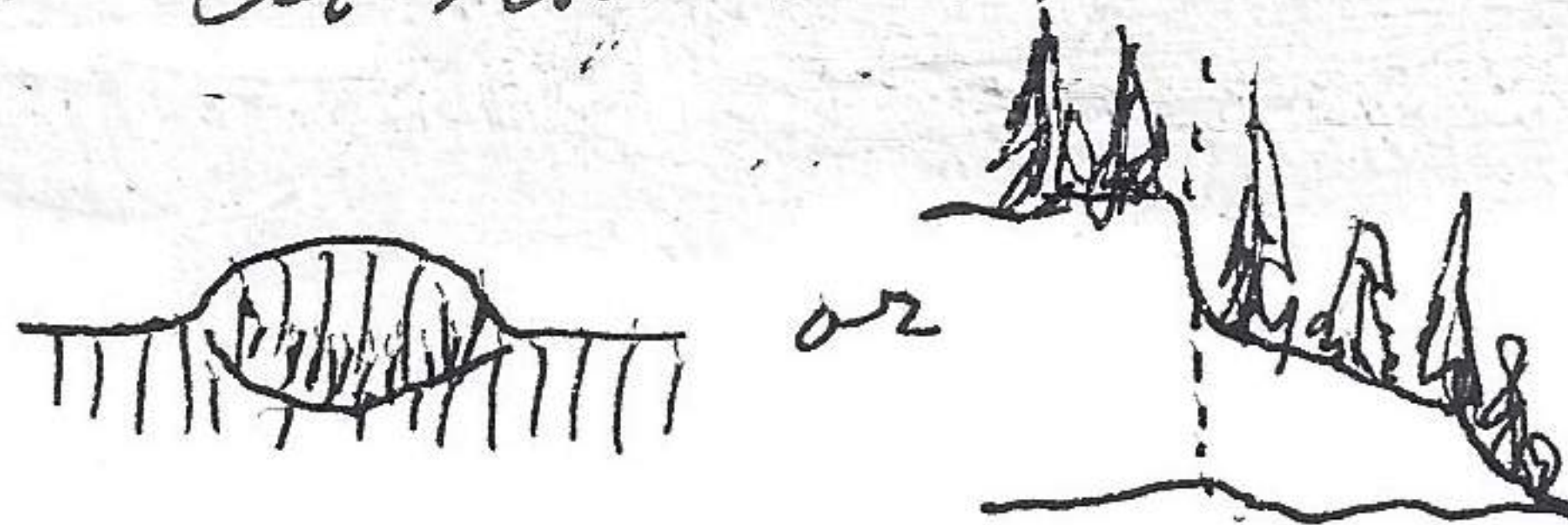
