

Nov. 2, 1988

Rain all night and waves 22 per minute on shore below Bee House.

Checked birds at Spencer Spit Lagoon this A.M.

35 mallards
28 pintails
31 American widgeon
2 bufflehead
11 shovellers
1 great blue heron
3 glaucous-winged gulls
1 Bonaparte gull
19 mew gulls
2 gadwall

While observing these birds an adult bald eagle flew 5 across lagoon at approx. 60' high; all birds left lagoon. Another bald eagle passed along shore-line approx 30' above trees and the birds in lagoon that had returned, remained in the lagoon. Flight pattern and speed of eagles determine birds reaction to their approach.

On Swift's Lagoon were;

10 shovellers

In Swift's Bay were 22 buffleheads and other unidentified birds

Rain and high wind all day and for first time this fall no mule deer came to feeder.

Nov. 3, 1988

High wind continued today.

11:55 A.M. ♂ mule deer 34" high at shoulders and antlers without eye tines (See June 22, 1988 for this buck in velvet).

After dark 3 different male mule deer, 2 ♀ adults and 2 fawns (of one of the females) arrived at feeder.
