Nov. 10, 1988

Return to Lopez from Chris' via Widbey Island. Dropped Matthew at at Shukitio play center. Cross to Widbey and continued N to Coupeville at which point observed in sound, 71 western gulls in a close-net group. also 17 white-winged scoters, 1 glaucous-winged gull, 2 raven, 2 common loon, 1 kingfisher, 19 common crows. 5 miles N Fort Casey 3 red-tails. Travelling S along edge sound by sailing only.

Continued N to Anacortes ferry terminal. In bay to SW are: 7 ♀, 8 ♂ huffleheads, 1 W. grebe, 3 white-winged scoters, 6 red-breasted mergansers, 63 glaucous-winged gulls on piling, 33 double-crested cormorants on piling (outermost ones). On piling at ferry terminal 8 pelagic cormorants. Left Anacortes ferry terminal at 8:59 P.M. white caps. 1 pelagic cormorant, 2 common murre, 9 cormorants (sp.) SW of Cypress Island, mew gull, 1 glaucous-winged gull, Lawson Rachs, 5 double-crested cormorants, 16 mew gulls on kelp, 1 double-crested cormorant, mew gull, common murre, W Thatcher Pass (W end inlet) 1 glaucous-winged gull, 4 double-
