

Rock. 80 Bonaparte gulls on kelp at base Lawson Rock. Another group approx. 250 beyond. 3 glaucous-winged gulls. No gulls on Pointer Island. SW Cypress Island. 4 common murre, pelagic cormorant, common murre, 8 common murre, 3 pelagic cormorants, mew gull, Arrived. Anacortes ferry terminal,

Nov. 19, 1988

at Chris' at Last Lake, 80 bush-tite in lower shrubs and trees. 1 goldfinch captured by house cat and it consumed it, Steve observed 2 ♀ mule deer at first U turn to N and also at bend below his home. Returned Lopez. Duck hunters in fields enroute, especially 5 end Padella Bay. Continued to Anacortes ferry. While waiting for ferry noted crows from singles, 2's, 3's and 4's arrive from N along shoreline and moved S to bay SW of ferry terminal and after approx 1 1/2 hrs. 100 or so birds ^{in one group} passed overhead and flew N. On piling in bay to SW of ferry terminal are: 180 gulls (glaucous-winged gulls and mew gulls), 14 cormorants sp., 1 red-necked grebe. Left 3:54 P.M. sky clear. Birds observed enroute: (ferry adjusting to 8' x 1' swells, Lawson Rocks. Bonaparte gull, 2 single glaucous-winged gulls. Wind Thatcher Pass. 2 single glaucous-winged gulls, 2 double-crested cormorants, 4 double-crested cormorants, 8 double-crested cormorants. Willow Island. double-crested cormorant, double-crested cormorant, glaucous-winged gulls, 2 single double-crested cormorants, 2 pelagic cormorants. Arrived Lopez Island

Nov. 20, 1988

11:05 From Bee House observed the following birds in one feeding group approx 1/10 mi SE.

13 glaucous-winged gulls

2 Common loons

18 pelagic cormorant

3 common murre

2 Horned grebes

8 mew gulls

3 Pacific loons

11 double-crested cormorants

1 western grebe

6 Bonaparte gulls

3:55 P.M. and Adult bald eagle soared directly SE over Bee House in ^{straight} a low angle descent to a common murre at an almost contact, the murre dove and the eagle immediately whirled upward and returned to a tree above Lichen Point.

4:10 P.M. 8 Bonaparte gulls, 3 mew gulls and 9 double-crested cormorants in fishing group approx 210' feet SE of Bee House.

4:14 P.M. Observed the daily flight ^(evening) of surf scoters from Swift's Bay.
