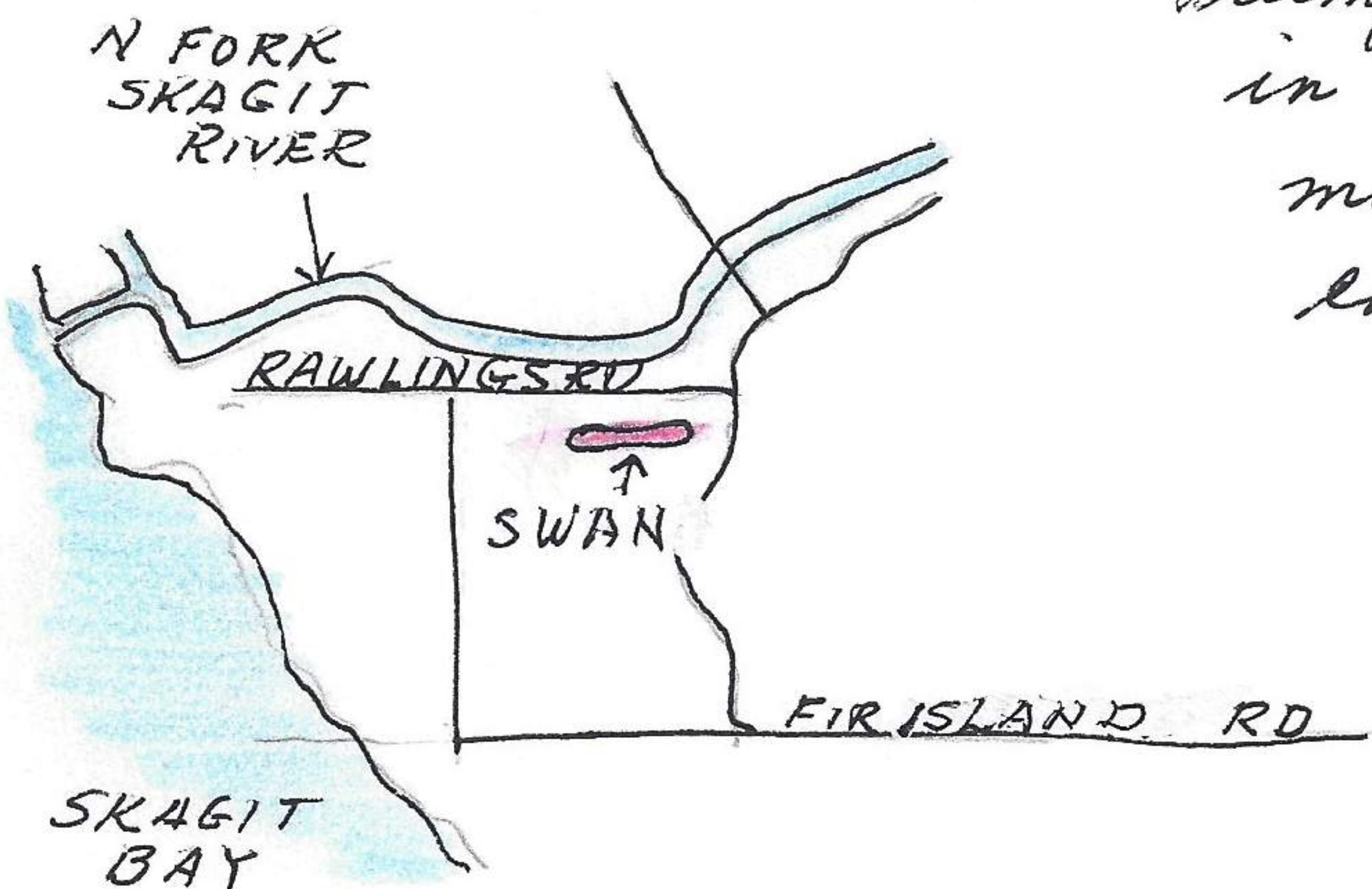


Dec. 1, 1988

On return from Chris' at Lost Lake, noted a pied-billed grebe in roadside drainage ditch,

at 3 mi. W and 2/10 mi. S on Rawlings Rd, noted 788

Trumpeters swan feeding and resting in a corn field (stubble). They remained while we observed and counted them.

83 common mergansers 60% males.

18 american chat

4:00 P.M. At Swifts Lagoon

19 shauellers

5 gadwall

4:30 P.M. At Bee House 6 glaucous-winged gulls done out 10' from shore in front of house and these birds only at first participated. Approx 2 minutes later 11 double-crested cormorants arrived as well as 2 red-breasted mergansers and immediately started to fish in a localized 10x10' area.

Dec. 3, 1988

881203-1 *Peromyscus m. hollisteri* 178-78-22-18-21gms ♂  
From Bee House.

3:30 P.M. 2 ad. bald eagles on Flower Island, one on rounded knoll near top and one in tree at N end.

On Leo Reef were 61 cormorants (both pelagic and double-crested, and 6 harbor seal.

Approx 150' S of Leo Reef. 32 common merganser formed variable formations from single line 2-2 1/2' apart to convergence into 2 sq.
