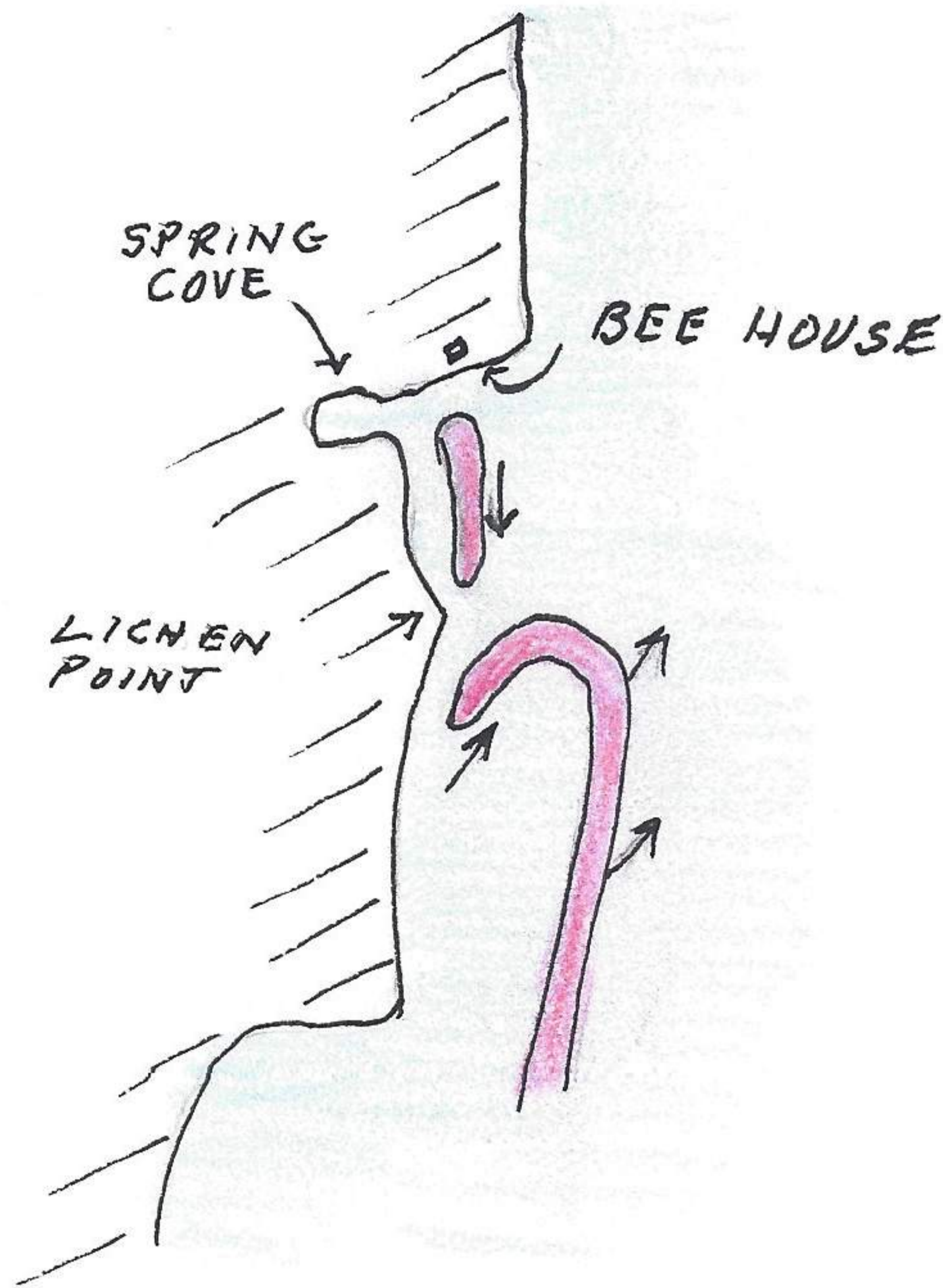

From 8:00 A.M. to noon, logs left Spring Cove and moved S around Lichen Point, then in addition to other logs from Surf Bay, moved N again to Lichen Point and then out into sound and aligned like a hook.

Two adult bald eagle sighting this afternoon.

3:45 P.M. Approx 1/2 distance between Leo Reef and Bee House is a feeding group of birds organized within an area of 30' x 30', and consist of:

- 19 double-crested cormorants
- 8 pelagic cormorants
- 6 glaucous-winged gulls
- 3 western grebes
- 2 red-necked grebes
- 2 common murrelets
- 1 marbled murrelet
- 4 hooded mergansers
- 24 common mergansers
- 2 red-breasted mergansers
