Dec. 20, 1988

Left Chris' for Lopez. At 1/10 mi S on Reservation Road off highway 20 a 2 point ♂ mule deer stood in middle road for 5 seconds as my car approached to within 40' then deer walked to edge of road and beyond.

Arrived Anacortes and left on ferry to Lopez Island at 8:52 P.M.

Dec. 22, 1988

Trip to Anacortes from Lopez Island at 2:45 P.M. Only birds observed on ferry <sup>trip</sup> were 1 double-crested cormorant and 1 glaucous-winged gull.

Electron and photon radiation at 12:30 P.M. then returned to Lopez. (Univ. Wash. med. center). 3:00 P.M. first nausea. 6:15 P.M. erythema of irradiated area

Dec 24, 1988

Day normal, skin normal, no pain associated with irradiation, no nerve damage.
