

Jan 13, 1990

1:30 P.M. 5 river otter swam to N past Bee House.
 3:25 P.M. To Lopez Village: Swift Lagoon; 27 American
 widgeons. E. side Fishermans Bay. Approx 250 common
 mergansers, one of which was 120 in one group, others generally
 distributed. On Fisherman Bay Causeway, on E side cause-
 way; 14 surf scoters, 1 great blue heron, 13 American widgeon,
 2 glaucous gulls, 9 black-bellied plover, 38 western sandpipers,
 2 small sandpipers sp.?, 4 American crows. One group of
 approx. 90 common mergansers flew W across causeway.

Jan. 14, 1990

2:00 P.M. no harbor seal on Leo Reef. Day rain and cool.

Jan. 15, 1990


The eastern gray squirrel, cut ears, at Bee House feeder.
 13 black turnstones and 5 surfbirds on shore below Bee
 House. ♂ mule deer, 2 point, 33" high at shoulders.

Jan. 17, 1990

At Fisherman Bay Causeway at SW end on E side of cause-
 way ^{at low tide} noted; 2 green-winged teal, one flock of 365 mew gulls on
 mud flat. 13 individual glaucous-winged gulls feeding along
 edge of water, 9 black-bellied plover, 18 western sandpipers,
 5 great blue heron, 15 bufflehead, ♂ & ♀ red-breasted merganser,
 8 American crows, 4 surf scoters, 1 killdeer, 2 double-crested
 cormorants. At Hummel Lake, one adult bald eagle top
 dead cottonwood tree E side lake. Swift Lagoon 9 American
 widgeons, Humphrey Lagoon, 1 mew gull, 4 bufflehead.

Jan 18, 1990

Sunrise 8:03 A.M. at junction N end Mt. Erie and ridge of
 Blakely Island. at this same time

approx. 220
 flew 5 past Bee 
 (out from shore) and settled in outer Swift Bay. They arrived
 in one irregular group of 2 V shaped formations. 46 of
 them swam N to Lichen Point then returned S to join main
 group. pelagic cormorants
