


Jan 23, 1990

8:45 A.M. 5 river otters swimming ^{to} 5 past Bee House and all successful in getting food. Put-out 3 times between here and Lichen Point.

Jan 24, 1990

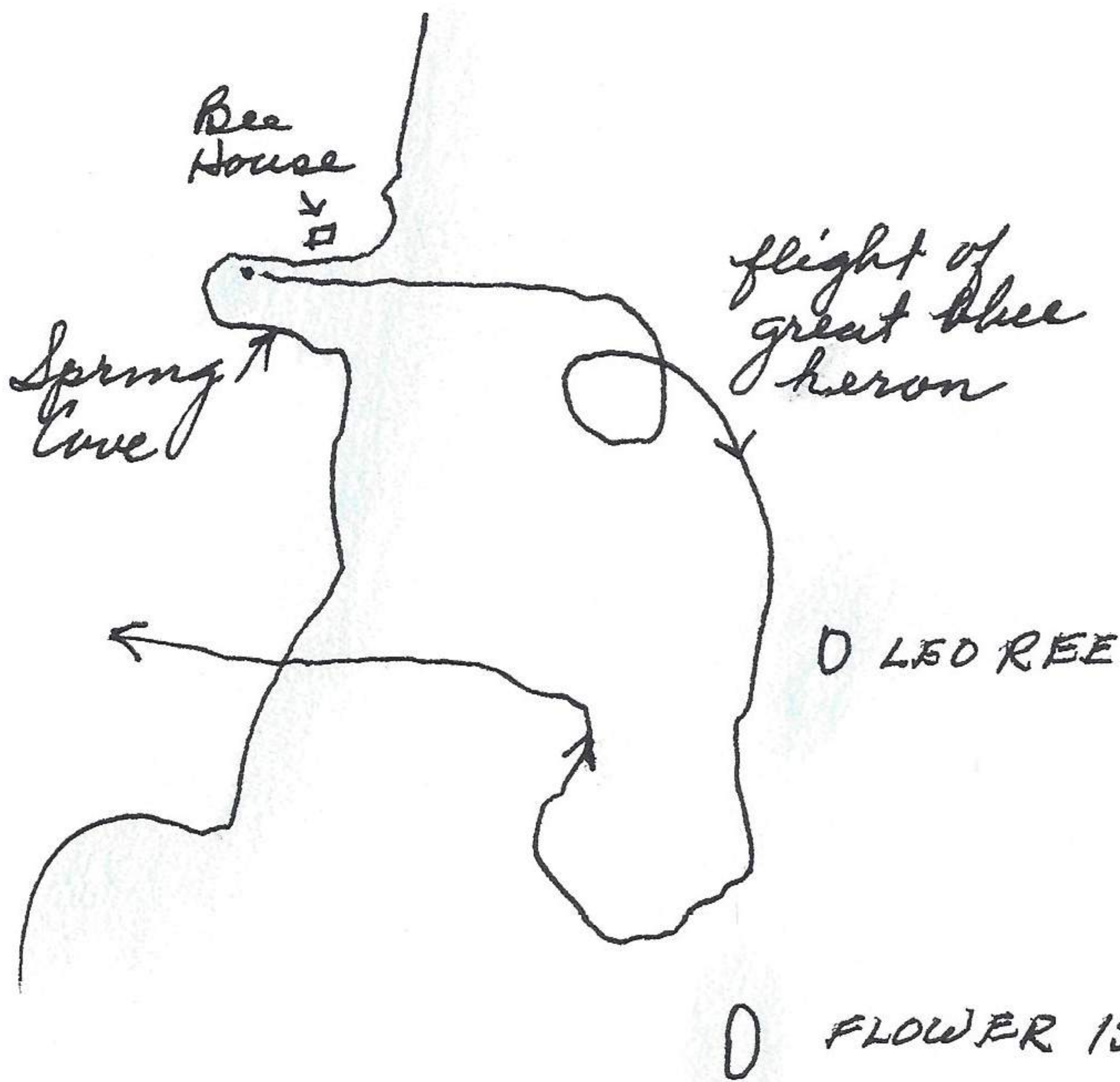
2:30 P.M. approx. 350 pelagic cormorant in sound between Bee House and Leo Reef. white-capped waves and cormorant diving off crest



Jan. 25, 1990

10:45 A.M.

Flight of great blue heron from Spring Cove, out over sound and thence W over Humphrey Head.



11:45 A.M. An adult bald eagle flew 5 past Bee House some 40' out and 60 high and alighted in Douglas fir tree above dissected Pt. 20' away from an imm. bald eagle. A mew gull was feeding on a scrap of debris (3"x3") out 150' from shore. The subadult left, displaced the gull and carried the scrap back to the same tree.

High wind today with waves 22 per minute. Also rain. Most wind up to 10:00 A.M.

Two groups pelagic cormorants, one of 198 E of Lichen Point and one of 145 $\frac{2}{10}$ mi E Boundary Point. The last group at one time moved $\frac{1}{10}$ mi. by flight.

4:50 P.M. One group 110 pelagic cormorants 150' N Leo Reef. Others have already left the area.

Jan. 26, 1990

10:07 A.M. 356 pelagic cormorant in one group $\frac{1}{3}$ way between Bee House and Leo Reef. 1 red-throated loon not associated with cormorant.
