Collected 3 ants from inside Bee House. First ab. seg. keeled.

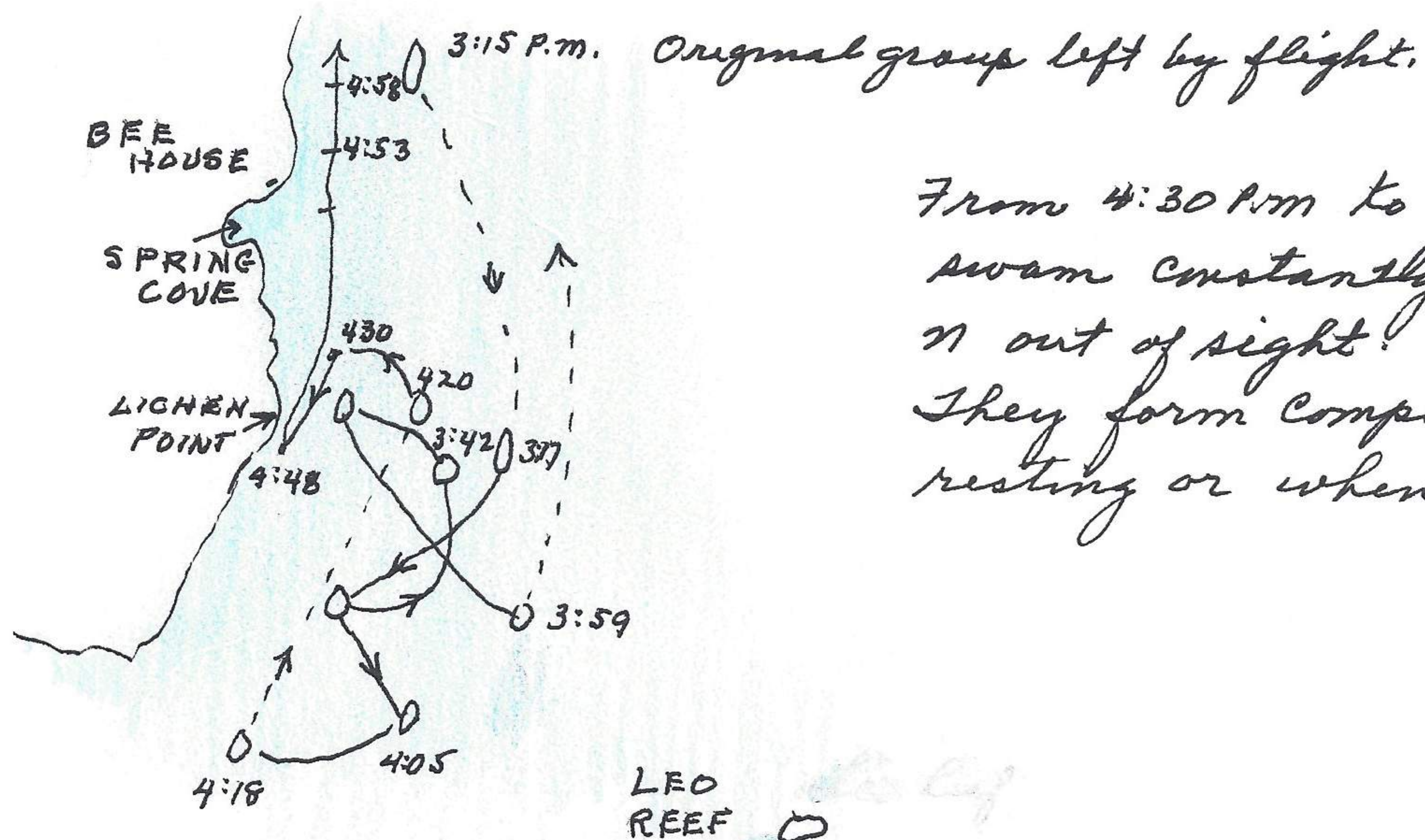
