

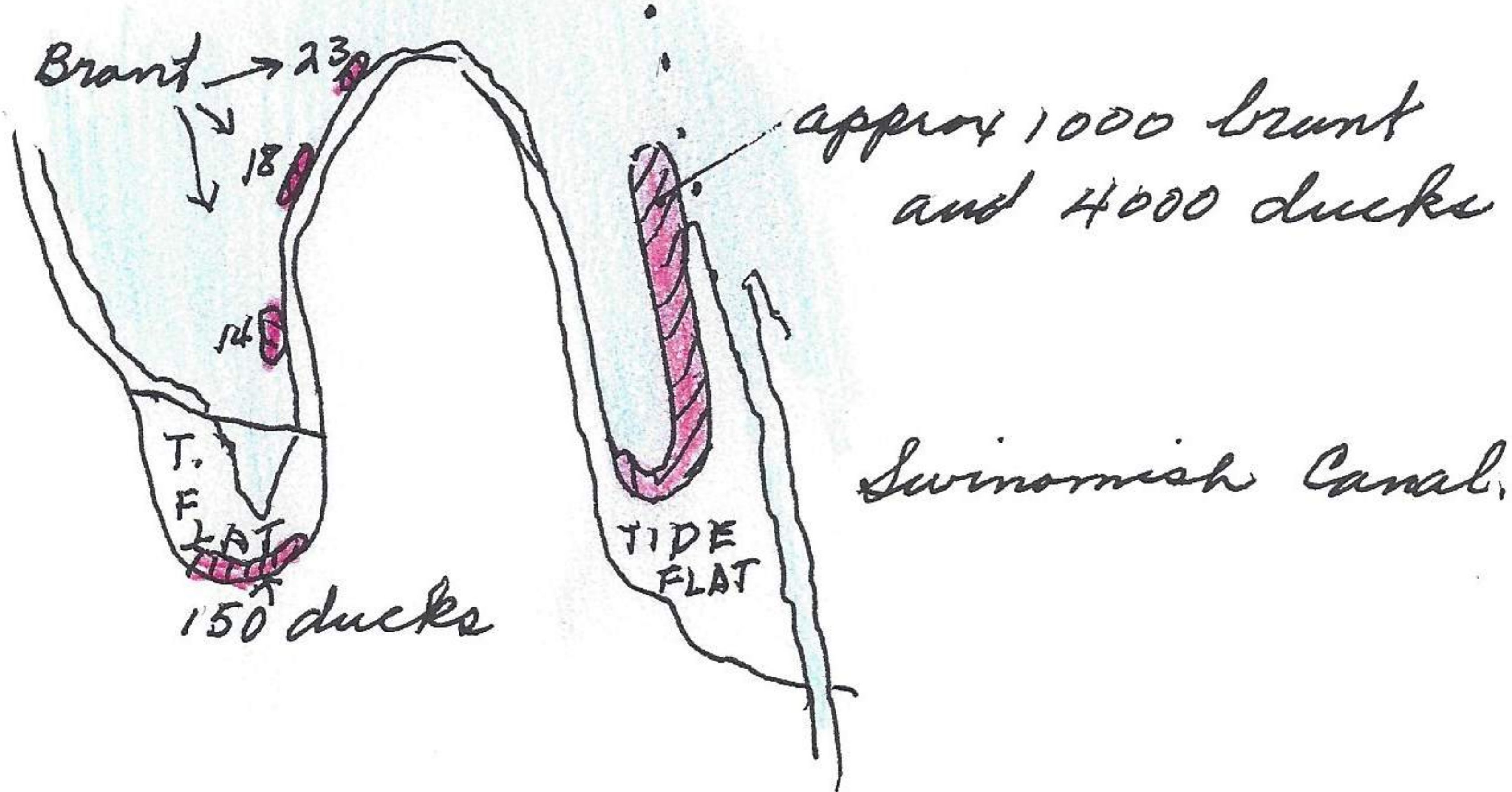
Feb. 15, 1990

Snow last night 1/2 way down slopes of Beakely and in Thatcher Bay the snow line dropped to 3/4 ^{to shoreline in places} down slope. Between entrance to Thatcher Bay to Round Peak are 22 open areas among the trees, made visible with new snow on ground.

To Anacortes and return; First time I have seen waterfall in Thatcher Bay from drainage of Spencer Lake, approx. 50' high. Arrive Anacortes. Red-tailed hawk at Swinomish Channel and highway 20.

checked marsh point then returned to Lopez Island.



Feb. 16, 1990

Wind from N. 26°F. wet snow fell last night to depth of 1 inch covering all trees and slopes.

10:00 A.M. Started to snow. Wet snow still on trees and ground!

10:18 P.M. 465 pelagic cormorants approx. 200' SE Bee House.
