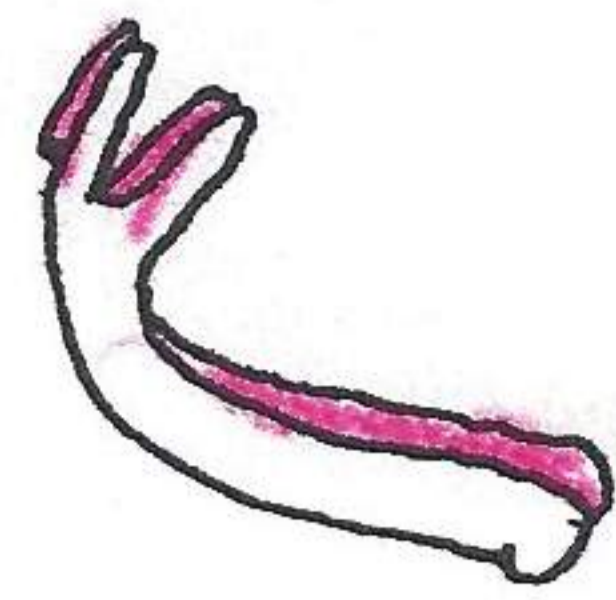


11:00 A.M. 2 point ♂ mule deer at feeder. It had snow on top of antler from snow of 10:10 A.M. and maintained snow for at least 1/2 hour.



No chipmunks since Feb. 12, 1990.

Groups 35-45 American crows feed at feeder at Bee House daily.

Purple finch 1-6 more numerous since snow period.

2:50 P.M. waves 23 per minute from N. Snowing and Temp. 24°F.

4:00 P.M. Collected yellow jacket from inside Bee House from under rug near window. Its number is 900216-1.

Water frozen in bird drinking fountain and the 3rd time this year.

Feb. 17, 1990

Temp. this A.M. 21°F. No snow last night.

11:40 A.M. 320 pelagic cormorants 10' to 80' out SE of Bee House. They swim towards Flat Point then E out onto North Lopez Sound, then S into Swift Bay beyond Licken Point.

12:30 P.M. <sup>night of</sup> snow of Feb. 15-16, 1990. Photo 900217-1 of Bald Bluff of remaining snow. Temp 43°F. Sun shining.

2:30 P.M. 108 pelagic cormorants in raft from 150 E Licken Point to E in line of Bee House and Leo Reef in 23 minutes without diving. One glaucous-winged gull was swimming with cormorants and was twice displaced by cormorants. Then in 5 minutes they made 3 dives that placed them 1.0 mi farther E.

3:45 P.M. Directly below Bee House 13 mew gulls systematically circled from 4' from shore to 50' off shore and covered same area on the outward circle path.

4:05 P.M. 1 double-crested cormorant, 1 hooded merganser, 11 pelagic cormorant, 3 common mergansers and 23 mew gulls fed in a 10' x 20' area below Bee House out 30'. Each time they moved out 50' (pelagic cormorants) and then returned for another dive. The mew gulls aggressively met the cormorants as they resurfaced. A better-kingfisher caught 3 candlefish in 4 mins.

5:32 P.M. ♂ 2 point mule deer 34" high at shoulders. The right antler had been shed.
