

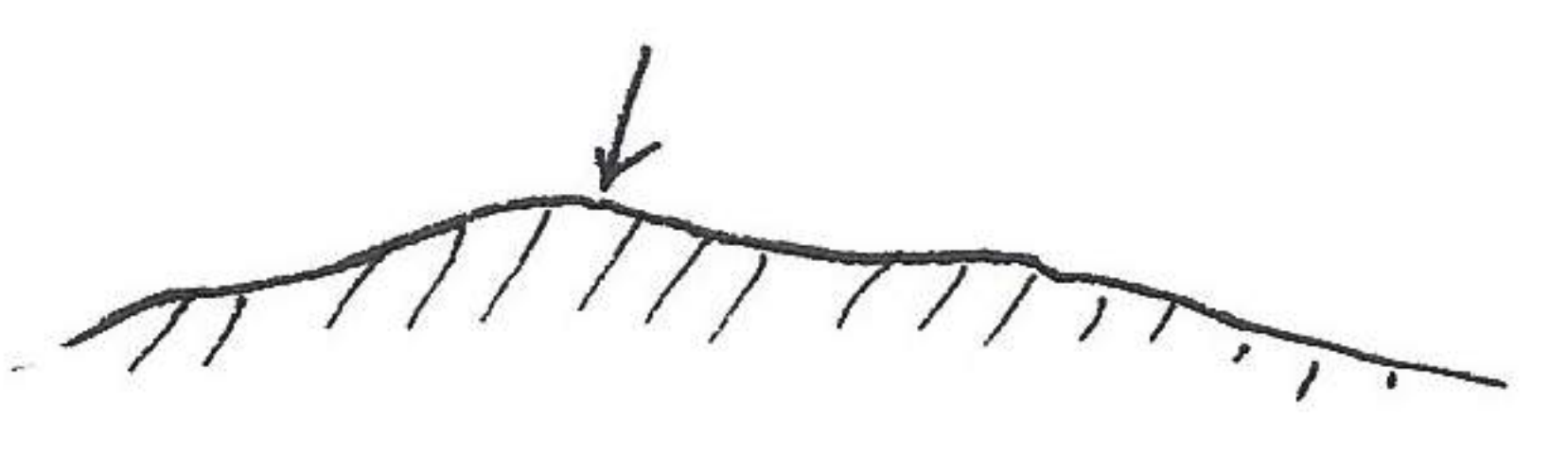
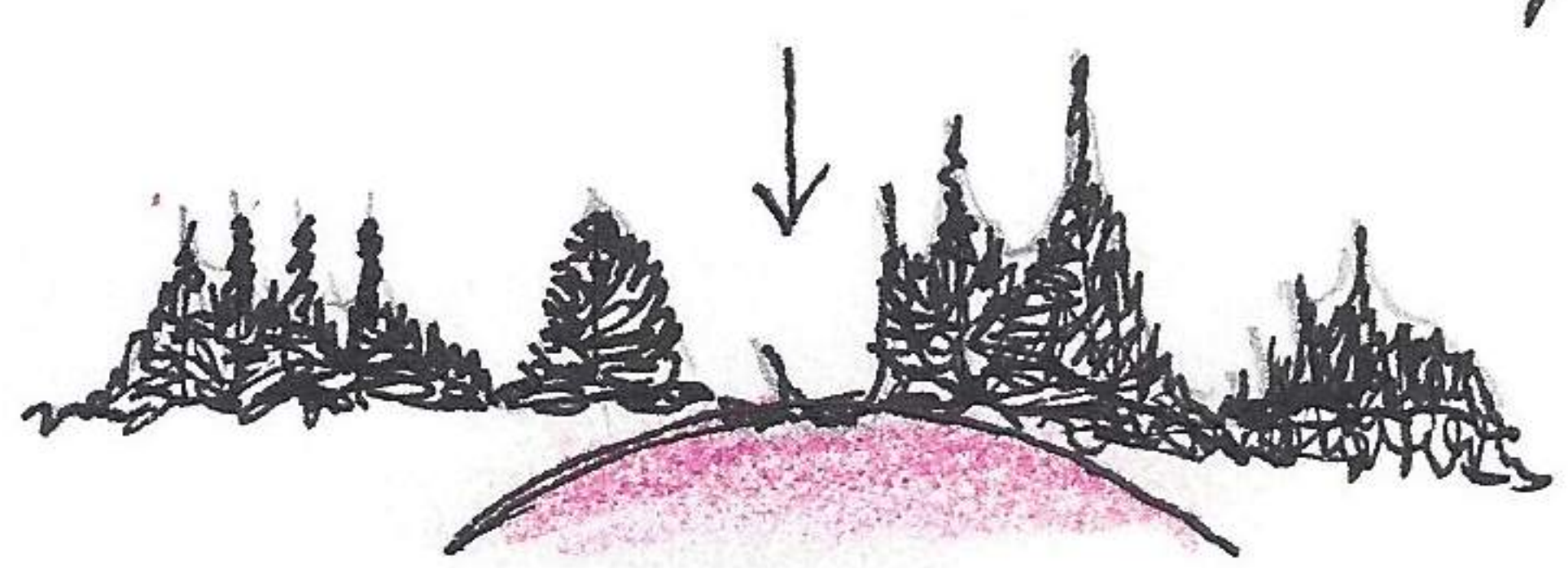
1:45 P.M. 18 harbor seal Leo Reef.
