2:00 P.M. 11 harbor seal on Leo Rock. 1 river otter swimming 77 out 20' from shore in front of Bee House.

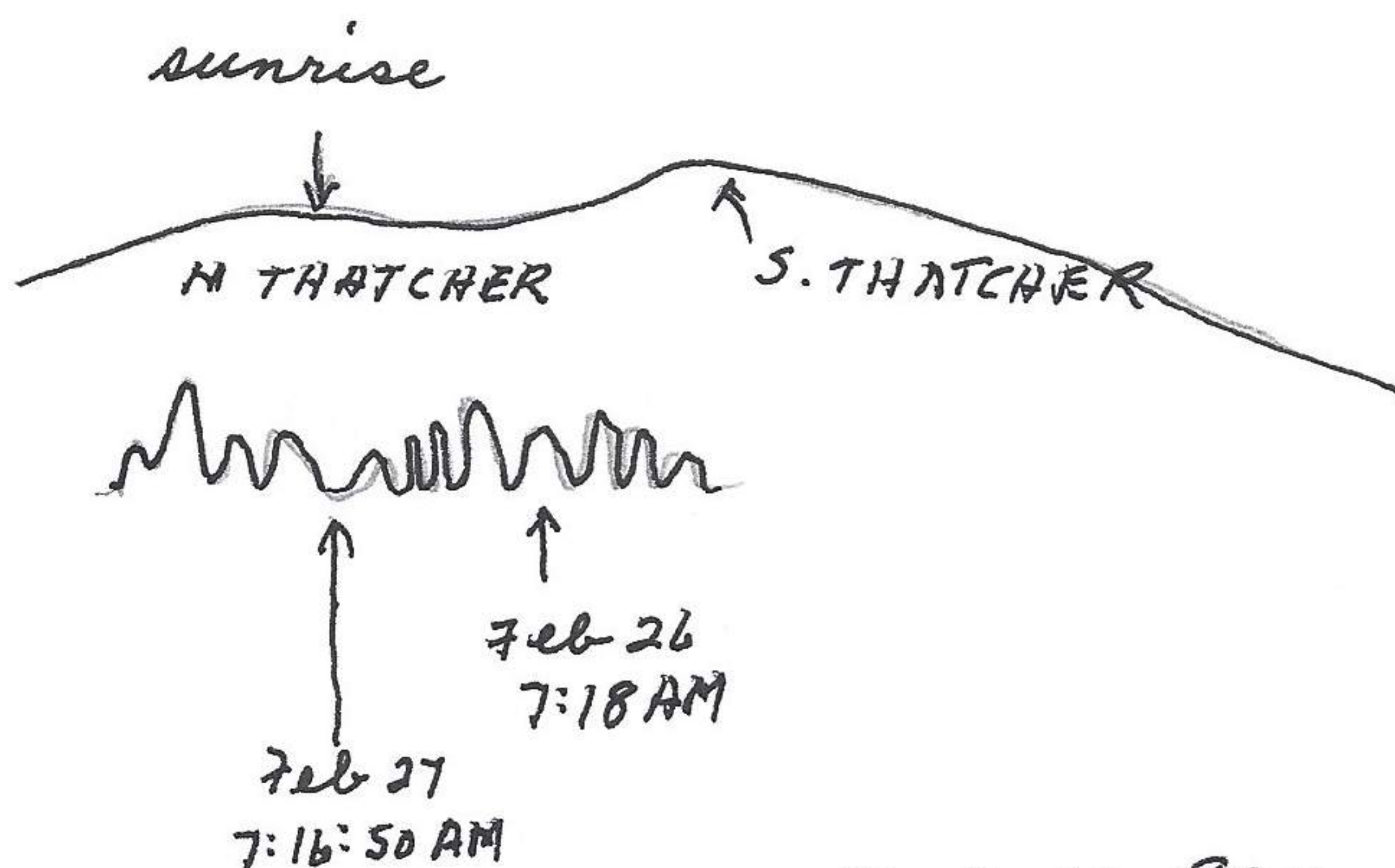
It is common for American crows to fly out ^{100'} from shore from porch feeder at Bee House and then return. If they want to gain altitude they circle upward once or twice and then move landward. At one time 11 left feeder and flew 5 toward Swift Bay Beach. At Lichen Point, 5 returned to feeder. When crows feed at Bee House, glaucous-winged gulls occasionally come to investigate activity.

2:25 A.M. Townsend chipmunk at feeder at Bee House and first sighting since last recorded in journal.

at causeway SW Fisherman's Bay (henceforth this secondary bay will be called ^{outh} S_N Fisherman's Bay). On W side causeway of 5 Fisherman's Bay are 53 ♀ and 4 ♂ red-breasted mergansers, 20 bufflehead ducks, 18 surf scoters, 1 double-crested cormorant. On E side of causeway in 5 Fisherman's Bay are 11 black-bellied plover, 8 western sandpipers and 6 glaucous-winged gull. also 18 bufflehead ducks, 6 scoup sp.?, and 4 red-breasted mergansers.
